STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

My Friend, Fred

One of my oldest and dearest friends died this Friday morning. Fred was an amazing character. He was a convert to Catholicism, a loyal and faithful husband, a father of four children, one of whom died in a freak accident a few months ago. He was a storyteller, an artist, a teacher, a coach.

Fred suffered. He physically suffered throughout his lifetime, starting when he was nineteen after a couple of accidents destroyed his hip. He was in and out of hospitals constantly. We all suffer but not many of us suffer as much as Fred did. And of course, this was almost overwhelming for his wife, Sandy and the children.



We tend to think that people should not suffer and of course we try to relieve suffering where we encounter it. But God allows suffering. He allowed Lazarus to suffer and die, and he allowed Martha and Mary to suffer for four days after their brother's death. Jesus himself suffered. He wept at the tomb of Lazarus.

St. John Chrysostom said this about this, "Many are offended when they see any of those who were pleasing to God suffering anything terrible. Those who are offended by this, however, do not know that those who are especially dear to God have it as their lot to endure such things, as we see in the case of Lazarus, who is also one of the friends of Christ but was also sick."

There's a mysterious reality about the Christian life that those who are called to

> a special holiness, those who in a sense God loves in a special way, he allows to suffer in a great way.

> Fred's suffering on earth is redemptive. He must have been especially dear to God to allow him to suffer so. Requiescat in pace, Fred.
