STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

"I will give you shepherds after my own heart"

"In these words from the prophet Jeremiah, God promises his people that he will never leave them without shepherds to gather them together and quide them: "I will set shepherds over them [my sheep] who will care for them, and they shall fear no more, nor be dismayed (Jer. 23.4).

The Church, the People of God, constantly experiences the reality of this prophetic message and continues joyfully to thank God for it. She knows that Jesus Christ himself is the living, supreme and definitive fulfillment of God's promise: "I am the good shepherd" (Jn. 10:11).

Without priests the Church would not be able to live that fundamental obedience which is at the very heart of her existence and her mission in history, an obedience in response to the command of Christ: "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations" (Mt. 28:19) and "Do this in remembrance of me" (Lk. 22:19) an obedience to the command to announce the Gospel and to renew daily the sacrifice of the giving of his body and the shedding of his blood for the life of the world.

By faith we know that the Lord's promise cannot fail.

The formation of future priests, both diocesan and religious, and lifelong assiduous care for their personal sanctification in the ministry and for the constant updating of their pastoral commitment is considered by the Church one of the most demanding and important tasks for the future of the evangelization of humanity."

These words come from St. John Paul II's Apostolic Exhortation, "Pastores Dabo Vobis." (I will give you shepherds...) He describes the need the Church has for, not just priests, but great priests, wellformed priests...really Good Shepherds. Priests that are not only faithful, but prayerful, well balanced, capable of bearing a load far beyond one's normal capacity to bear sorrows and tragedies and frustration, other people's sufferings and pains and to help and guide his flock back through the gate that is Jesus Christ.

The world needs more good priests. Our Archdiocese needs more good priests. And for that, we need to pray. This week, we will be setting aside time for Eucharistic Adoration in the church and invite you to come and pray for vocations, especially to the priesthood. (See page 2 for details). 
