

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

Christ, my hope, is risen. Just as he said!

The Resurrection of Jesus shows us with clarity that our end is in Christ. There is a beautiful homily from the second century in which the author imagines what Jesus has been doing when we say, 'He descended into hell'.



Jesus descends into hell in order to bring back the captives. He takes Adam by the hand to lead him and Eve and everyone who is willing to risk freedom and says, "Awake, O sleeper, and rise from the dead, and Christ will be your light."

He goes on:

"I am your God, who for your sake have become your son. Out of love for you and for your descendants, I now by my own authority, command all who are held in bondage to come forth, all who are in darkness to be enlightened, all who are sleeping to arise. I order you, O sleeper to awake. I did not create you to be held prisoner in hell. Rise from the dead, for I am the life of the dead. Rise up, work of my hands, you who were created in my image. Rise, let us leave this place, for you are in me and I am in you; together we form only one person and we cannot be separated."

What an incredible teaching of the Catholic Church: you are in me and I am in you; together we form only one person and we cannot be separated. We are truly one in God. That is the reason for Creation and the reason you and I were born. To be in him and him in us.

That is the power of the resurrection! We cannot be torn from Christ by any force: We are in him and he is in us.




