Today, I'm thinking about Rachel's Vineyard, which is a retreat offered for those who have suffered a loss due to an abortion decision. Because Our Lord is so merciful, is reaching out to those who are hurting from such an experience. It is a completely confidential and safe environment for women (and sometimes husbands). I have met several women and men who have attended a weekend retreat and they are transformed.

I think of Retrouvaille, a three-phase program for couples that teaches how to heal and renew their They marriages. work communication techniques, forgiveness, healing, and restoration of trust.

But the Lord is here for us if we allow him in; if we can trust in him. Paul Simon who is not even Christian seems to think we can trust in God, that we can allow him into our messy lives.


