STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

It's All About the Spirit!

The big rush of a violent wind, tongues of fire dancing over the Apostles heads, the Apostles being understood in languages they had never spoken before; the Holy Spirit was upon them. Christ told them he was sending the Advocate. They waited... and BOOM! It happened.

Who is this Holy Spirit that acts so strangely? The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches us that there are three Persons, equal and distinct in God: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The Father and the Son (the Word made flesh), love each other from eternity and the expression of this love from all eternity is a third person, the Holy Spirit.

He is called Spirit according to the Latin sense of the word which means 'vital breath'. He is called the "Spirit of the Father and the Son" and "the Spirit of love in God" and "the breath of divine love". He is the Spirit of Christ, the Spirit of the Church, and the Sweet guest of the Soul. As the soul is the principle of life in the body, the Holy Spirit is the principle of life in the Church, the Mystical Body of Christ.

He is all these things but most importantly for us, *he is the Sweet Guest* in our Soul by way of our baptism. The Holy Spirit dwells in us always, which makes us Temples of the Holy Spirit.

And the Holy Spirit comes to us in a special way on the day of our Confirmation. This Sunday, we have five young people who having completed the other Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confession, Holy Eucharist) will be receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation. They are: Bethany (Max) Quek, Arianna Cyrus Allen-Bonilla, Maneclang, Ferdinand Samuel Dupa and Sanca Tran.

By this gift of the Holy Spirit, these young people will be more fully conformed to Christ and will be strengthened with the power to bear witness to Christ. They are marked with a seal of the Lord which can never be erased, altered, or repeated.

Let us pray for our Confirmandi, that, with the constant help of the Holy Spirit, they will become true witnesses for Christ and never be afraid to speak to everyone they meet about the Good News of Jesus Christ.
