

Which never can be filled*

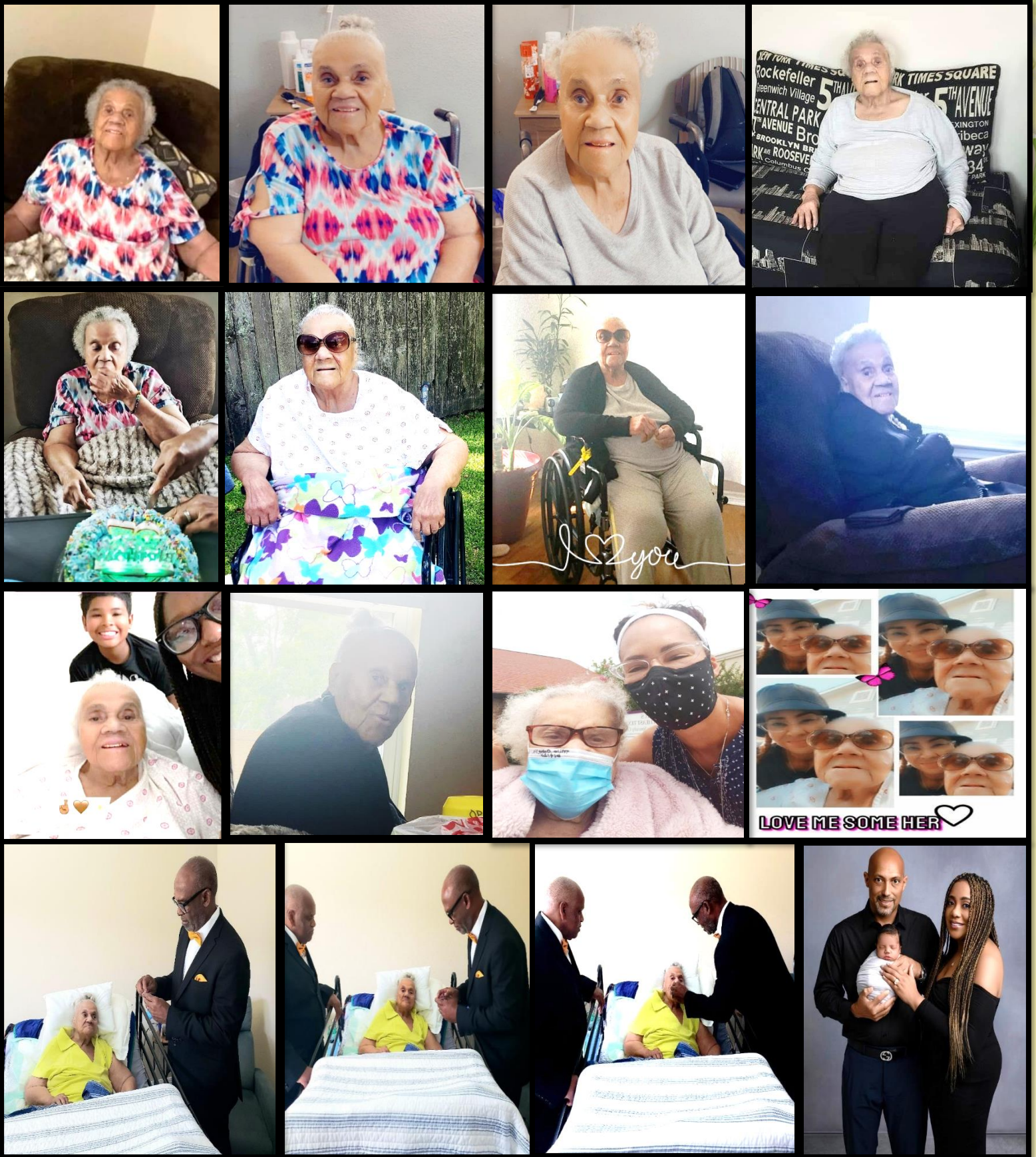

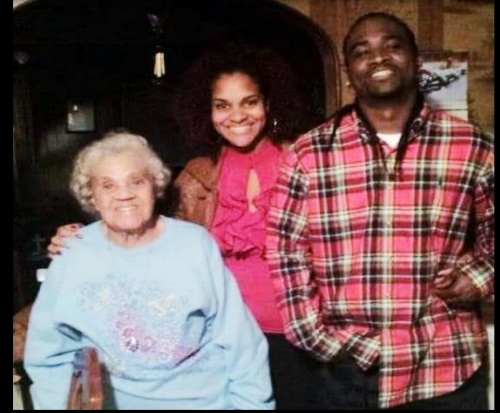
