I turned my back and left it all.*

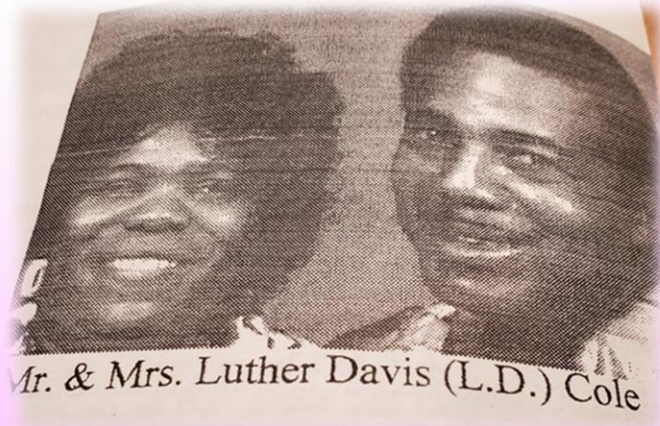
*I could not stay another day,
