The heroic Ofra operation is an affirmation of our people's choice and legitimacy in resisting the Zionist occupation and its settlers. It proves that any attempt to condemn the Palestinian resistance will fail in the face of the desire and valiance of our Palestinian people.

This is Hamas. Dedicated to the elimination of the Jewish State of Israel and her people. Any means by which this can be accomplished to end the "occupation" and "invasion" of their so-called Palestinian land is legitimate. So, "heroic" drive-by shootings are "valiant", and Allah is thereby glorified.

As reported by Reuters on December 6,

"A U.S. attempt to get the United Nations to

condemn violence by Palestinian militant group Hamas for the first time failed . . . because the draft resolution fell short of votes needed in the General Assembly.

"The resolution required two-thirds support and while Assembly resolutions are non-binding, they can carry political weight. The U.S. text received 87 votes in favor, 58 against, 32 abstentions and 16 countries did not vote.

"In an earlier procedural move requested by Kuwait, the 193-member body narrowly voted to require two-thirds support and not a simple majority for adoption of the draft resolution."



This took place on Thursday, December 6^{th, 2018.}

Just three days later, on Sunday, the 9th, and almost as if empowered by the UN's cowardice, the shooting took place in Ofra Junction. On Tuesday, the 11th – within one week of the UN's failed vote – baby Amiadi Israel was dead.
