

# Mike's Top 3 Bets NFL Week 6

Sunday October 15, Carolina Panthers+13.5 Detroit Lions-3 Indianapolis Colts+4

This week I'll be going over each game and my top 3 listed above. Thursday Night

Denver+10.5 is a spread range dog and due up for the third time. They managed to push on my number against Chicago where both teams were due up. This is also their 3<sup>rd</sup> game on the road in 4 weeks. They will face Kansas City again in two weeks at home. This is the biggest number (+10.5), and although I don't like to two fails on the due upside, I still lean to Denver. The Broncos are 3-0 ATS last 3 vs KC and Sean Payton is 9-3 as a road dog.

Sunday Baltimore-4 at Tennessee

I don't have much on this one. The line is the same as my power rating and this is Baltimore's 4<sup>th</sup> road game in 5 weeks and it's in London. Baltimore dropped a lot of passes last week. I'm passing on this game.

## Washington at Atlanta-2.5

My power ratings favor the Falcons by 9, mostly due to Washington's rout losses of 3-37 (PHL), and 20-40 (CHI). The Redskins tried to bounce back against Philadelphia and did cover the spread but are 0-1 in the division with the Giants and Eagles again coming up. I'm not thrilled with Atlanta's QB Ridder, but he had 329 yards passing and no interceptions last week, so I'll take Atlanta laying less than a FG.

## Minnesota at Chicago+2.5

My power rating favors the Vikings with a point of value, but they lost Jefferson last week so I would make Chicago a slight favorite. I won't touch this one but if I did, I would have to take the Bears home.

## Seattle at Cincinnati-3

My power ratings favor the Seahawks by 1.5, giving me 4.5 points of value. Seattle is coming off a bye week. I had this game figured at 6.5, but the injury to Burrow decreased the line the first 4 weeks. Burrow looked like his old self last week so if the Bengals can keep him upright, they should be able to cover. The Bengals are a spread range favorite (3-1-1 ATS). Seattle lost to the Raiders off the bye week last season, and they went on the bye week feeling pretty good about themselves routing New York 24-3 so I'll lean to the Bengals-3 at home.

#### San Francisco at Cleveland+6

I guess to win this one you must step in front of a moving freight train. The 49ers are star due down, which means they are hot. They demolished Dallas and could be due for a slight letdown here. Cleveland is a spread range dog, so we have two of the tools working for us in Cleveland. I would be set to jump all over the Browns, but we have a QB? and it is trending that P.J. Walker will take the job Sunday. We need that 24-point offensive average, not the 3 they scored last week. I just wonder if the coach is sandbagging. They are coming off a bye week! Power ratings favor the 49ers by 7.5, so I would feel better with 7 if we can get it.

#### Carolina+13.5 at Miami

Well, if we survive the freight train, maybe we can stand on the runway to watch the planes take-off. Carolina is a spread range dog and possibly due up. The point spread also gives Carolina 2 points of value. Those are three strong indicators siding with the Panthers. Carolina is on a 4-2 SU and 5-1 ATS run in pre-bye week games vs AFC opponents. Miami lost one of their bullets, Achane for a while so I like the timing here, but we will need some points. Top 3 play.

### Detroit-3 at Tampa Bay

The Lions handled the first two NFC South opponents by an average score of 31-15. My power ratings give the Lions a half point advantage. Ironically, both Detroit and Tampa Bay are possibly due down so in that case I go with the power rating edge. The Lions have Montgomery back and should move the ball with a balanced offense. Tampa Bay has defeated 2 NFC North opponents 23-17 average against Minnesota and Chicago, but they meet the cream of the crop in this one. Tampa Bay is off a bye week and has Atlanta waiting on deck. I'll take Detroit and lay the 3. Top 3 play.

### Indianapolis+4 at Jacksonville

The Jaguars come back home after two weeks in London. I would have to think they will be a little sluggish this week. They did get two wins over there and now face a revenging Colts team for the week one defeat. Richardson is out for the Colts and Minshew will take over again. My power rating favors the Jaguars by 1.5, but jetlag and an experienced QB to go against should make this one not only close, but a possible loss for Jacksonville. Top 3 play

#### New Orleans at Houston+1.5

My power ratings favor the Texans by 1 so we have a little value there. Houston is 13-8 and 15-6 ATS in pre-bye week games since 02. This is the Saints 4<sup>th</sup> road game in 5 weeks. They are coming off a rout win, (6-10 ATS this season). If Stroud can stay interception free, they have a good chance to take this one.

### New England at Las Vegas-3

After two straight routs, the Patriots have been outscored 72-3! The Patriots are due up, who wouldn't be. Belichick has been a master of coaching for a long time, and he usually corrects the deficiencies, but this team may have too many to fix. This is the Patriots 3<sup>rd</sup> road game in 4 weeks. My power ratings favor the Raiders by 5 and as much as I would like to take New England, I must pass.

## Arizona at Los Angeles Rams-7

My power ratings favor the Rams by 10.5 so we have some value with the home team. I don't have much to use in this game, but I like the fact that Cooper Kupp is back, and we should start seeing more scoring from the offense. Arizona has been competitive in most of their games, but their defense is slipping some allowing 35, and 34 points the last two games. RB Conner is out which could make their offense one dimensional, and that won't be good against the Rams. I like Rams-7 or less.

### Philadelphia-7 at New York Jets

The Eagles are playing their third road game in 4 weeks, my numbers favor them by 9. I'm watching to see if this number goes up to 7.5 and then I'll play against the Eagles. Teams laying 7.5 or more on the road are 0-3 ATS this year.

#### New York Giants+14 at Buffalo

The Giants are a spread range dog, star due up, and playing their 4<sup>th</sup> game in 5 weeks on the road. Daniel Jones and RB Barkley are still questionable. The Bills could still be dragging from the trip to London, but they are coming off an upset loss, and they rebound well. As much as everything points to NY, the Bills are favored by 22 in my power ratings. Pass

## Dallas-2 at LA Chargers

Dallas is coming off a rout loss. This is their 3<sup>rd</sup> road game in 4 weeks. They lost a LB and WR /PR Turpin. The bye week helped the Chargers heal and RB Ekeler looks to be back. The line is tight, slight lean-to Dallas-2.

## Breakdown of the rest of the tools

Teams Due Down- San Francisco-6
Teams Due Up- Denver+10.5, New England+3, New York Giants+14
Teams possibly Due Down- Detroit, Tampa Bay
Teams possibly due up-Carolina+13.5
Spread Range Dogs- Denver, Cleveland, Carolina, N Y Giants
Spread Range Favorites-Cincinnati

The spread range helps if you get an agreement with the power rating or the dues. Spread range favorites are 3-1-1 ATS. Cincinnati is the only one that meets this situation. San Francisco is due down and Cleveland is a spread range dog. This would constitute a play on Cleveland if we knew who the QB was going to be.

Carolina is possibly due up and they are getting 2 points higher than the line. This looks to be too many points and a spread range dog makes them worth a play. Denver+10.5 meets the spread range and they are due up. The number is high for a division game and with two situations agreeing I'll bite here.

Detroit and Tampa are in the same situation so taking the power rating is the next best thing, so I like Detroit. The Giants fit two situations, but I won't be playing them until they show some offense. Jones is questionable and beat all to hell from the sacks he has taken so can't play them.
