The recent shooting rampage at Michigan State University is but another example of a country divided: Those who are begging political leaders for sanity when it comes to gun control; and those who believe that the Second Amendment means anyone, anywhere, for any reason, of any age, should be able to own any kind of weapon, including assault ban weapons that were designed to be used only on a battlefield.
