Easter Choices



During Holy Week, we will walk through the anguish of Gethsemane, to the darkness of the shadow of the Cross. Throughout the Lenten Season, we have considered in Mark and John's Gospels the hard choices that Jesus made and now, with the coming of Easter, we will consider the choices we make as well.

The choice is our's on whether we leave this Good News of the Resurrection inside the walls of our church; or – as the women did at the tomb – will we share this wonderful story with others? Jesus IS alive, and he is calling us to proclaim the good news of the Resurrection to others. Who in your circle of family and friends needs to hear the Hope and Promise of Easter? Now is the perfect time to share the Gospel!






