**TODAY IS THE FIRST SUNDAY** of a new Church Year, and the beginning of the four week Advent Season. Worship in Advent takes on a different, more reflective tone in music, prayers, confessions, etc. — as the Church waits and watches for the coming of the Christ Child.

Advent wreaths began in Lutheran Churches in Germany to mark the weeks before the coming of Christmas. **Blue** is the color of Hope and the color associated with the Virgin Mary, and so is used during the four weeks of Advent...and not at any other time in the Church Year.

Our Gospel reading for this year will primarily be from St. Mark — the earliest and shortest Gospel. St. Mark has a breathless, rapid quality about it — Mark's favorite word is "Immediately..." a word which links together all the many activities of Jesus, as Our Lord heads to the Cross and His moment of Glory, Grace, and Reconciliation. We're glad you're with us in Advent Worship as we read, pray, study, and prepare.
