PREFACE




C He is risen indeed! Alleluia!

- C We are the Easter people who have placed our hands in his side and felt his wounds. He was once dead but now is alive. He has been raised by the triumphant power of the Almighty God. He is risen!

廿 GOSPEL Mark 16:1-8

The resurrection of Jesus is announced, and the response is one of terror and amazement.

- P The Holy Gospel according to St. Mark, the sixteenth chapter.
- C Glory to you, O Lord.

When the sabbath was over, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices, so that they might go and anoint Jesus' body. ²And very early on the first day of the week, when the sun had risen, they went to the tomb. ³They had been saying to one another, "Who will roll away the stone for us from the entrance to the tomb?" ⁴When they looked up, they saw that the stone, which was very large, had already been rolled back. ⁵As they entered the tomb, they saw a young man, dressed in a white robe, sitting on the right side; and they were alarmed. ⁶But he said to them, "Do not be alarmed; you are looking for Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He has been raised; he is not here. Look, there is the place they laid him. ⁷But go, tell his disciples and Peter that he is going ahead of you to Galilee; there you will see him, just as he told you." ⁸So they went out and fled from the tomb, for terror and amazement had seized them; and they said nothing to anyone, for they were afraid.

- A Following his resurrection, the Lord Jesus breathed peace upon his disciples. We share in this peace of Christ in the Church today. The peace of the Lord be with you.
- C And also with you.
- A Please greet those around you with words of peace.

PRAYER

P God of mercy, we no longer look for Jesus among the dead, for he is alive and has become the Lord of life. Increase in our minds and hearts the risen life we share with Christ, and help us to grow as your people toward the fullness of eternal life with you, through Jesus Christ, our Savior and Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.

C Amen.

Words of Institution

P In the night in which he was betrayed, our Lord Jesus took bread, and gave thanks; broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying: This is my body, given for you. Do this for the remembrance of me.

Again, after supper, he took the cup and gave thanks, and gave it for all to drink, saying: This cup is the new covenant in my blood, shed for you and for all people for the forgiveness of sin. Do this for the remembrance of me.

LORDS PRAYER

- P Gathered as one by the Holy Spirit let us pray, as Jesus taught.
- C Our Father, who art in heaven,

hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come,

thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses,

as we forgive those who trespass against us;

and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

For thine is the kingdom,

and the power, and the glory, forever and ever. Amen.

Invitation

P The risen Christ is made known to us in the breaking of the bread. Come and eat at God's table.

You may receive the Elements as the words are said: The Body of Christ given for you; The Blood of Christ shed for you.

- P Almighty God, who raised our Lord Jesus from death, lift you up and restore you to wholeness.

- P Jesus Christ, the Word of life, bless you and send you to be his witnesses.

- P God the Holy Spirit, who renews the whole earth, refresh you in the gift of baptism this day and always.

C Amen.

RESPONSE

- P The empty cross announces God's victory!
- C Alleluia! Praise God!
- P The empty tomb testifies that Jesus Christ is our risen Lord.
- C Alleluia! Praise God!
- P May our discipleship proclaim the living Christ and God's love for all people!
- C Alleluia! Amen!
- P Go in peace. The Spirit send us forth to serve. Christ is risen.
- C Christ is risen indeed! Thanks be to God. Alleluia!
