Spiritual Morsels

("If the world is against truth, then I am against the world!" St Athanasius the Great)

I am not afraid of hell and I do not think about Paradise. I only ask God to have mercy on the entire world as well as on me.

OUR LOVE IN CHRIST MUST REACH ALL PLACES, EVEN TO THE HIPPIES IN CRETE. I VERY MUCH WANTED TO GO THERE, NOT TO PREACH TO THEM, OR TO CONDEMN THEM, BUT TO LIVE WITH THEM, WITHOUT SIN OF COURSE, AND LEAVE THE LOVE OF CHRIST TO SPEAK OF ITSELF, WHICH TRANSFIGURES LIFE.

There is an electric generator and in the room is a lamp. If, however, we don't flip the switch, we will remain in darkness. Similarly, there is Christ and there is the soul. If, however, we don't flip the switch of prayer, our soul will not see the light of Christ and will remain in the darkness of the devil.

CHRIST IS OUR FRIEND, OUR BROTHER; HE IS WHATEVER IS BEAUTIFUL AND GOOD. HE IS EVERYTHING. IN CHRIST THERE IS NO GLOOM, MELANCHOLY OR INTROVERSION, WHEREAS MAN SUFFERS FROM VARIOUS TEMPTATIONS AND SITUATIONS WHICH MAKE HIM SUFFER. CHRIST IS JOY, LIFE, LIGHT, THE TRUE LIGHT, WHICH MAKES MAN GLAD, MAKES HIM FLY, MAKES HIM SEE ALL THINGS, SEE ALL PEOPLE, SUFFER FOR ALL PEOPLE, AND WANT ALL PEOPLE TO BE WITH HIM, CLOSE TO HIM. **ELDER PORPHYRIOS**

WE DO NOT KNOW EVERYTHING ABOUT THE CONFLICTS OF THIS WORLD, NOR IS IT NECESSARY TO KNOW. WE JUST PRAY WITH A COMPASSIONATE HEART FOR THE PEACE OF THE WORLD AND FOR ALL. WE DO NOT TAKE SIDES, BECAUSE EACH SIDE WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR CRIMES, AND WE DO NOT WANT TO SHARE IN THESE CRIMES AND BE CONDEMNED. IF WE PRAY FOR THOSE WHO ARE MORE WRONG THAN RIGHT, WELL, WE PERFORM THE COMMANDMENT TO LOVE EVEN ENEMIES. AND IF WE PRAY FOR THOSE WHO ARE MORE RIGHT THAN WRONG, WE DO WELL. THEREFORE, WE CANNOT GO WRONG IF WE PRAY THAT GOD SAVE ALL AND GRANT PEACE TO THE WORLD. ESPECIALLY FOR US, PRIESTS AND MONKS, IT IS VERY IMPORTANT NOT TO BE POLITICAL AT ALL, BECAUSE WE OFFER OUR SACRIFICE TO GOD, THE HOLY LITURGY, FOR THE WHOLE WORLD; AND IF WE ARE FOR SOME AND AGAINST OTHERS, OUR SACRIFICE IS ANNULLED. I THINK THAT WHEN THERE IS A WAR, THE BEST IS NOT TO BE JUDGMENTAL, BUT TO HAVE COMPASSION AND PRAY THAT THE LORD MAY SPARE ALL FROM SUFFERING. IF MY LITURGY IS TO HAVE ANY VALUE, NO ONE SHOULD BE MISSING FROM MY HEART WHEN I STAND BEFORE THE ALTAR OF GOD AND SAY TO HIM, "THINE OWN OF THINE OWN, WE OFFER UNTO THEE, IN ALL AND FOR ALL."


ARCHIMANDRITE ZACHARIAS ZACHAROU

"At a certain monastery on the Holy Mountain [Mt. Athos], there is a mural that represents the Second Coming; and shows the judgment of people's souls. Each soul passes by, one-by-one, and is measured on God's scale. For one specific soul, that person's Guardian Angel has also brought forth some small packages. However, the scale tips toward the side of the demons. Very saddened by this, the Angel looks for a way to make the scale tip to the side that his soul may be saved. Looking around, he finds a small handkerchief that had been dampened by this soul's tears of repentance. When he places this on top of the scale, it suddenly tips to the Angel's side;... and the soul is saved. Do two drops of tears bear such great weight? From a material standpoint, their weight is insignificant. However, they have great weight from a spiritual perspective. Because repentance is of such value that, no matter what the devil has on the other side, repentance can tip the scale towards the side of the Angel, so that the soul can be saved."
