Lesson 2: Healing Under Both Covenants

Lesson 2 Text: (*Isa. 53:4-5*)

- I. The order of receiving divine revelation to man is, line upon line, precept upon precept, here a little, there a little. (*Isa. 28:9-10 - Whom shall he teach knowledge? and whom shall he make to understand doctrine? them that are weaned from the milk, and drawn from the breasts.¹⁰ For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, and there a little:)*)
 - A. Each successive revelation builds upon the previous revelation.
 - B. The Lord is greater than your last revelation of Him.
- II. God is not a God that changes. (*Mal. 3:6 - For I am the LORD, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed.*) Whatever God tells us about His nature, character, or personality; He always is the same.
 - A. He introduced Himself to Israel as Jehovah-Rapha'. (*Read Exo. 15:26*)
 - B. He promised to take sickness out of their midst. (*Read Exo. 23:25*)
 - C. He promised to take away all sickness. (*Read Deu. 7:9-15*)
 - D. The name of the Lord is strength for us. (*Pro. 18:10 - The name of the LORD is a strong tower: the righteous runneth into it, and is safe.*)
- III. Go to the lost sheep of Israel. (*Jer. 50:6, 17; Eze. 34:2-6*)
 - A. The disciples sent to lost sheep of the House of Israel. (*Mat. 10:1, 5-8; 15:21-28*)
 - B. The Old Covenant was given to the Jewish People.
 - C. The covenant benefits belonged to the children of the covenant. (*Mark 7:27 - But Jesus said unto her, Let the children first be filled: for it is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast it unto the dogs.*)
 - D. The children bread are the rights afforded to them by the covenant.
- IV. The disciples are later sent to all nations. (*Mat. 28:18-20; Mark 16:15-18*)
 - A. Isaiah prophesied of Jesus death providing healing under the New Testament. (*Isa. 53:4-5*)
 - B. Jesus confirmed Isaiah prophecy. (*Mat. 8:16-17 - When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick:¹⁷ That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.*)

- C. Peter testified that the New Covenant included healing. (*1 Pet. 2:24 - Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.*)
- V. We have a better covenant based on better promises. (*Heb. 8:6-8 - But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises.*)
