ACCREDITATION: John Carroll University is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission.

CREDIT HOURS: The semester credit hour is the official unit of instruction. One semester credit hour is awarded for a minimum of one class hour of direct faculty instruction (the class hour is defined as 50 minutes) plus a minimum of two hours of out-of-class work each week delivered over a 15-week term. In addition to the consecutive weekly format, courses may also meet in a variety of compressed formats of varying length within the beginning and ending dates of a given semester or summer term.

OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS: An official transcript is printed on safety paper with blue ink, bears the signature of the registrar, and does not require a raised seal. Please see below for additional authenticity tests.
