#### From the President

Summer normalcy...almost! As the Country and Ohio are easing COVID mandates and relying on retail stores, offices and hospitals to establish self guidelines, MPCA is *near ready* to enjoy our southern shore of Lake Erie with its water views, sunsets and amenities. As you can see, the cement patch on the shallow end of the pool bottom designates its repair. In lieu of delaying its opening, the Board decided to postpone the the scheduling of the entire pool painting until fall to maximize the time Mother Nature allows for its enjoyment.

The Clubhouse and its restrooms are open for owner use, however group reservations including weekend gatherings using the interior amenities, remain restricted. Soon to be available, an online digital calendar will be on MPCA owner's website for scheduling the Clubhouse's reserve. Along with the current rules governing its use, other changes along with scheduling availability, will be announced thru email communication later this month.

As warmer days approach and local Lake water temperatures rise from their current 55 degrees to the mid 70's, algae blooms are created by a combination of sunlight, and less disturbed water found in protected shoreline areas near the beach. The variety of blue-green algae in the lake is known as cyanobacteria and its microscopic organisms that are found naturally in surface water, can sometimes multiply into harmful levels. The algae blooms can produce extremely dangerous toxins and cause <u>illness</u>, <u>irritation</u> and even death in pets, livestock and humans.

Health officials advise that pets and young children are most susceptible to getting sick from the algae because they have a lower body mass than adults and are more likely to ingest the water. The take away is, while your young ones and furry friends enjoy the beach and it's waters, be cognizant of their surroundings...be safe and enjoy your time with us this summer.

We have had our roofer/sliding maintenance company out to fix a number of small roof leaks and some siding issues that resulted from the major storm we had the weekend of May 28<sup>th</sup>.
