A Note from the President:

Splish Splash, the sounds we'll hear from the MPCA swimming pool in the next few months. A welcome sound it will be! Winter has not been too bad at the lake; however, we certainly have had a few snow and ice events that make everyone look forward to spring.

With Spring fast approaching, we have been working to complete several projects that were scheduled last year.

1. All the trees (23) on the property have been trimmed or, as the contractor says, "raising the tree umbrella." I think they did a nice job, and I'm sure you'll notice a difference. 2. Regarding the swimming pool, we are moving forward with the lighting project. The four poles and fixtures surrounding the pool area will be replaced with new poles, fixtures, and bases. The light poles and the fixtures have been ordered and are in transit. We anticipate the contractor will begin demolishing portions of the project in early April and completion of the project by the end of April or early May. All of this, of course, is "weather permitting." The timing could be affected by rain or snow. Please be aware that during the initial phase of this project, there will be days when there will be no electricity in that area and very minimal lighting (if any) around the pool. The new poles and fixtures will be a welcomed addition/upgrade to the swimming pool area. 3. The cameras for the dumpster areas in the parking lots should be installed and operational in the next month or so. 4. MPCA has purchased a new computer. The security system for the pool key fobs and clubhouse has been installed into the new computer. This should eliminate or at least mitigate the occasional outage of the security system due to a weak internet signal. 5. The board is progressing on completing the parking lot lighting project. 6. Progress continues with the parking lot side walkways/stairs/support beams project. 7. Progress is continuing with hiring an accounting firm to perform financial reviews of MPCA. 8. Progress is continuing with hiring a reserve specialist to assist us in the "setting" of reserves. This should put us in compliance with Ohio Condo Law.


