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A Note from the President:


MPCA Homeowners,

Mother Nature has been kinder than normal this winter, so snow removal fees have been lower than anticipated. Anyhow, any savings will be transferred into our reserves account or be used where costs may be elevated during the rest of the year. TBD.

As I view the lake, please be aware of the potential for "drop off areas" while swimming. To me, it seems that ever since last year's revetment project at Saybrook Township Park, possible sand disruption or lake water flow patterns may have changed, thus helping to fill in our swim area? I share this information as a possible concern, especially for children. We approved the purchase of a life ring for the lake area, and it will be predominantly displayed in case of an emergency.

Improvement projects on the 2023 agenda:

- Total resurfacing of the west parking lot and filling the cracks and resealing of the east parking lot. This includes freshly painted parking spaces and handicap areas.
- 2. Phase I of sidewalk leveling. The plan is based on identified high risk areas. The board had to break down the sidewalk project into phases due to budget and project pricing. If we have any savings elsewhere in our maintenance budget, the board will discuss the total replacement of areas not deemed repairable by the contractor, Valley.
- 3. Deck inspections both common and limited common areas. Due to ageing (over 20 years), as well as last summer's findings regarding Bldg. #3's decking conditions, the board contacted K & C and sought qualified inspectors for bidding. The board received two bids; one contractor bid significantly more than the other, therefore Globex was awarded the job.
- 4. New LED lighting by the pool areas and the walkway to the beach steps. Finding interested commercial electrical contractors have been very challenging,
