



Mabel Dobbs




Many people know Mabel Dobbs for her colorful outfits, blingy jewelry, myriad of boots, her incessant energy despite her 81-years young, or her benevolence and volunteerism. However, many people have no idea how Mabel got here.

Born in Oklahoma during World War II, the oldest of three children, Mabel changed schools 13 times in 12 years, following her parents to different jobs, as her father was a union plumber, which probably made her as personable as she is. After graduation, Mabel married, moved to New Mexico and had three children, Kim, Ron, and Zane. Mabel began her career in banking in 1961 as secretary for Albuquerque Federal, the largest savings and loan in the state, by 1978 Mabel had managed several branches and had been promoted to Vice President, the first woman to hold the title.

Mabel's banking career continued into the state of Nevada, but she always had a yearning to live in Montana or Idaho. In 1981 she took a position as

the manager of a small, private bank in Salmon, Idaho, where she met her "cowboy", Grant Dobbs, a rancher and former bull-rider, and the love of her life for 33-years, until his passing in 2017. Mabel left the bank and became a

full-time rancher's wife in 1984 and settled into cattle ranching, having and irrigating in the Challis, Idaho area. On their few excursions from the ranch, it was always to a rodeo or a PBR, and Mabel and Grant travelled to most of the "big ones" Mabel became quite a hand through the years, mounted on her strawberry roan, Kim, and tackled some wicked terrain, storms, poor cattle prices, horse wrecks, and broken equipment on their ranches in Challis, northern Nevada, Jor-



tions, but she would put her horse away occasionally and go to the house if the redheaded cowboy yelled at her like a hired hand too many times.

Through trials and tribulations within the ranching industry, the Dobbs' "called the trucks" in 1992 and called it quits. However, ranching is a blood-borne disease and they found themselves back on a piece of ag. property on Mann Creek raising hay, and before too long a small herd of Longhorn cross cattle. Later Mabel and family began Mann Creek Bucking Bulls, which has since moved to Utah. Mabel went back into banking to fund their ranching habit, working as the senior loan underwriter for Idaho Housing Agency, and later as a mobile loan originator for Valley Mortgage, Republic Mortgage and Family Mortgage. Many hearing this story probably had help from Mabel to get your home loans.

In 2009 Mabel left the work force to take care of her ailing parents, but before too long was pulled back in because of



her 30-years of experience in grassroots and non-profit organizations to head the local cancer group of Angel Wings Network. Mabel is passionate about what Angel Wings does and who they help in our local rural communities. Mabel is also passionate about her family: Her two remaining children, Kim and Zane, her 6 grandchildren and her 6 great-grandchildren. She loves spending time with them even if it is at a hot Weiser Valley Round-Up, of which she has been a member since 2008, and continues to take money at the gate every year. Thank you Mabel for all you do for the community and the Weiser Valley Round-Up!

Scott Ellwood Memorial Scholarship



For well over 20-years, Scott Ellwood was a fixture among the Weiser Valley Round-Up Committee members. He served as both President and Vice President through the years, and was the resident "poster hanger", distributing WVR advertising posters throughout the area. Every July, Scott could always be found during the annual rodeo in the back pens sorting roping cattle with precision.

On November 3, 2021, the world lost a wonderful person when Scott Ray Ellwood past away at home and was called to heaven at the age of 49.

Although Scott is no longer with us here on earth, he will always remain in our hearts and memories.

As an added tribute to our good friend, the Weiser Valley Round-up Association has begun the Scott Ellwood Memorial Scholarship Fund. Every years a male and a female Washington County senior that is involved in rodeo, 4-H, or FFA will be awarded a scholarship. The WVR Scholarship Committee is proud to announce the 1st Washington County recipient:

Quinci Marvin is the daughter of Kurt and Kendra Marvin, and a 2023 graduate of Weiser High School. Quinci has been active in FFA, Basketball, National Honor Society, Red Wave Club, and Idaho High School Rodeo Association.

Quinci will be attending Lewis and Clark State College in the Fall of 2023, where she will study nursing. Quinci plans to work in a hospital setting as a floor nurse and an operating room nurse, eventually hoping to become a traveling nurse.

Quinci has had many successes in the FFA showing market swine, and breeding beef and competes in barrel racing, breakaway roping, and team roping in the IHSRA.






*** The Rules ***

Multiple cows will be loose in the arena. Teams include 1 roper and two ground men or "muggers". The roper MUST serve as the milker. The cow must be roped with a legal head catch, milked while standing up, and cannot be tied off hard and fast to the saddle horn. The rope must be completely removed from the cow before the time stops for the team. Time will be stopped when the milker enters the finish circle, and at least one drop of milk must run out of the bottle in the finish circle. Contest will end when two teams have reached the finish circle with a qualifying drop of milk in their bottle. Bottles must be inspected by the judge prior to the event beginning. If all spots are filled, there will be

12 teams participating in the event: 6 teams on Thursday, July 11th and 6 teams on Friday, July 12th. The top two teams from each night will return on Saturday, July 13th for a final payout round and a buckle.







Our Beginning:

Founded in 2008, in Weiser, Idaho, by Breast Cancer Survivors; Angel Wings Network Inception came to be from the number of people our founders met while going through breast cancer treatment. People who were going through cancer all alone, without a support system, or family.

Cancer patients in our rural communities are in greater need of support and assistance due to many factors, including but not limited to, aging population, lower income status in rural counties, geography, lack of insurance or health care practices, financial and economic hardships related to the disease.

Mission Charitable Giving:

To provide support to cancer patients, survivors, caregivers, family and loved ones who have been touched with cancer, in our rural communities.

Source of income:

Individual donations, fundraising events, and grants.

Community Impact Areas:

Rural areas in Southwestern Idaho and Southeastern Oregon: A 70 mile radius from Weiser, Idaho, with a static or direct impact area 70 miles from Weiser.

Communities and Counties:

Providing support in Seventeen (17) Communities in Eight (8) Counties in areas of Southwestern Idaho (McCall, Indian Valley, New Meadows, Council, Cambridge, Midvale, Weiser, Payette, Fruitland, New Plymouth, Emmett, Parma, Caldwell and others) and Southeastern Oregon (Ontario, Nyssa, Vale, Huntington, and Baker).

AWN Patients Services:

Patients may talk one-on-one or by phone for emotional support as part of our CANCER CARE PALS, Financial Advice and Network Support, Gas Cards, Prayer Blankets, Transportation to Chemotherapy, (Wheels to Recovery) Radiation and Doctor Appointments. AWN also provides Grocery Cards, Meal Train and Meal Certificates, Education and Awareness classes, Library of Books, reference material and information, and many other services as needed.

Volunteer Outreach Services and Community:

Patient support and outreach is offered every Wednesday in Ontario, Oregon at Saint Alphonsus Medical Center Cancer Infusion Suite.

"Wheels to Recovery" Volunteer Transportation to Treatment Program. Providing patients transportation to and from Chemotherapy, Radiation, and doctor appointments. We have 12 volunteer drivers, two donated transport vehicles, and our drivers drove over 22,000 miles in 2022 and

donated 16,000 volunteer hours. AWN also gave out \$21,225 in fuel cards and \$15,615 in grocery and meal cards.

Our Vision:

We strive to grow and establish outreach locations of our organization within rural communities. Become a recognizable name and place for cancer patients, caregivers, survivors and family to find hope, faith and support. Help educate the public and bring a bigger awareness to all types of cancer.

Many people with cancer in rural areas do not have a close neighbor or social network to provide help as they struggle with the disease. Our focus is to establish a stronger relationship with churches, and social organizations who will become our outreach partners. To further help cancer patients in rural locations, who may not otherwise know about or have the opportunity to receive the benefit of our program services.

Our Goal:

To continue to grow and support our network of patient/member services in rural areas within a 70-mile radius of Weiser. Establish sustainable funding to continue our mission, goals and vision. Continue to develop a vital adult and youth volunteer program. To build strong relationships with key partners such as churches, social & civic organizations, medical facilities, and partnering stakeholders.
