CODE OF CONDUCT

All participants and their parent and/or guardians, hereby specifically agree and understand that their behavior, activity and actions at National Derby Rallies (NDR) events are of the utmost importance to the viability, reputation and functions of the NDR.

While at this event and any affiliated sites including Hotels, Campgrounds, Restaurants, etc, participants will be supervised at all times by their parent and/or guardian.

We understand that the NDR Board of Directors may withdraw the participant or prohibit any individual in violation of this Code of Conduct from the event site if they are involved in any behavior deemed to be detrimental to the health, safety or welfare of other participants, spectators, event staff, race sites, affiliated properties (e.g. Hotels, Campgrounds, Restaurants), or is involved in actions considered to be detrimental to the viability, reputation, goals and objectives of the NDR and its Host City organization.

Participation in NDR events is a privilege and subject to the observance of the organization's rules and procedures. Any participant, parent/guardian, director or volunteer who violates this code is subject to discipline, up to and including removal from the event. The activities outlined in the following list are strictly prohibited:

- Abusive language toward an event volunteer, participant, director or spectator.
- Possession or use of alcoholic beverages on event property or excessive usage of alcoholic beverages at affiliated lodging and restaurants.
- Damage or destruction of property at race sites and any affiliated lodging and restaurants.
- Bringing onto event property dangerous or unauthorized materials such as explosives, firearms, weapons or other similar items.
- Discourtesy or rudeness to a fellow participant, volunteer, director or spectator.
- Verbal, physical or visual harassment of another participant, volunteer, director or spectator.
- Actual or threatened violence toward any individual or group.
- Conduct endangering the life, safety, health or well-being of others.
- Failure to follow any NDR policy or procedure.
- Bullying or taking advantage of any other participant(s).
- Failing to cooperate with the board of directors, its policy or procedures.
- Not demonstrating the values of honesty, respect and responsibility.
