Requirements:

- Applicant should be a recent graduate of high school, or a graduating senior entered solely into a technical, university, or secondary educational setting. Adults who are reentering college will also be eligible with proof of acceptance into such a program of study.
- Applicants must have maintained a SCWHA membership for at least six months prior to applying. Family or individual memberships will satisfy this requirement.
- ➤ Preference will be given to applicants who have shown an interest in the recognized horse breeds of the SCWHA High-Point Program. Such breeds include, but are not limited to: Tennessee Walking Horses, Racking Horses, Spotted Saddle Horses, and non-registered gaited horses. Participation includes: showing under saddle or at halter, grooming, or regularly attending and/or supporting the SCWHA affiliated horse shows.
- ➤ This application and all required documents must be postmarked or emailed by June 15th of the current year.
- ➤ If the scholarship recipient is unable to fulfill their course of study, all funds must be returned within six months.
- Applicants must re-apply each year for consideration.
- The SCWHA scholarship may be awarded to the same applicant only twice.

Ensure that you have submitted the following:

- A. SCWHA Completed Scholarship Application
- B. Written Essay: Typed in 12 pt font, double-spaced. Choose ONE of the following topics:
- 1. How has the Tennessee Walking Horse (or the breed that you show) industry impacted your life?
- 2. Where do you see yourself in five years? What is your plan to arrive at that goal?
- 3. How will you make a difference in the Tennessee Walking Horse industry?
- C. An official transcript, or current report card from your educational institution (If applicant is a graduating senior)
