*Note: Response times include everything from the time we get the first “tone” to the time we arrived on scene. Times range from 2 minutes to 25 minutes depending on the distance from the station.

**Note: No-transport figures are for every time the service gets called. Many of these are standbys, canceled calls, and no patient found/presented. Our Medical Director’s stats give us a no transport rate

of 26.0% over the last 2 quarters. I have compared these to numbers from other services in this area that go up to 50%!
