# Who Is TRC

The REENTRY Center of Brevard (TRC) helps citizens from returning incarceration with assistance for successful re-entry into our community. This Re-entry initiative will allow returning citizens access to vital postservices (e.g., housing, release cognitive-behavioral employment, intervention, health care, job placement training, mentoring, and counseling) with the intent of helping them successfully transition back into the community through a continuum of care that will offer returning citizens support to succeed. The REENTRY Center Portal staff will also contact inmates releasing to Brevard County prior to release to begin the re-entry transition planning. The primary outcome of The REENTRY Center of Brevard County Re-entry Portal is to increase public safety by reducing recidivism.



#### Pre-release programming and services we provide include:

- Development of Individualized Release Plan
- A review of your driving record and payment plans established for you with the Clerk of Court.
- A review of eligibility for SSDI, SSI, and SS for those that qualify for those programs
- Programming provided include 24/7
  Dad; Support4Families for your family
  members as they prepare for your
  release; and Cognitive-Behavioral
  Interventions (CBI) to help you plan for
  your success.
- If an out of state birth certificate is needed, we can order for you.
- · Coordination of housing prior to release.
- Upon release, a welcome home package that includes work related clothing, toiletries, bus pass, and your case manager will help you apply for food stamps.

#### **Post-release** programming and services we provide include:

- Development of Individualized Release Plan if not already completed.
- Transitional Housing. .
- A review of your driving record and payment
- Assistance with seeking permanent housing plans established for you with the Clerk of Court. Even if you have never had a driver's license, we will help you secure your driver's license with our DS Project. The DS Project works: just ask the 79+ clients who we have helped secure a valid driver's license!
- A review of eligibility for SSDI, SSI, and SS for those that qualify for those programs.
- Programming provided include 24/7
  Dad; Support4Families for your family members as they assist you after release; the MRT-DWLS/R Program that helps you understand how to secure a valid driver's license and how to keep it; Cognitive-Behavioral Interventions (CBI) to help you plan for your success; Grief Recovery Class; and Florida Ready to Work Program, which is an Online Skills Assessment and Career Readiness Program. Financial incentives may be provided for completion of these programs.

#### <u>Post-release</u> programming and services we provide include cont.:

- Healthcare connection to the Brevard Health Alliance (BHA).
- Counseling service referrals that are paid for by The Reentry Center of Brevard for substance use disorder and mental health needs. Vocational Training.
- · GED Prep Class and GED Test.
- · Job Connections.
- We schedule and pay for an eye exam and glasses up to a certain dollar amount.
- Bus Passes.
- Food.
- A welcome home package that includes work related clothing, toiletries, bus pass, and your case manager will help you apply for food stamps. Once employed and you need basic work tools, we may be able to assist with purchasing tools. If a Florida ID, birth certificate, or social security card is needed, we will order for you.

Call or stop by our location when released to enroll, if not already enrolled.

Our office hours are 9am to 5pm Monday through Friday.
