Militias and patriots terrorized

□ In joint U.S. and British psyops exercise

Confuse and decimate, divide and conquer, the core strategy of kings and generals from the beginning of man's manipulation of human-kind right up to the present day. There are no leaks. No vacations were cancelled, no leaves were recalled. Rumors abound.

March brought stories of a planned attack by federal agents and military forces upon patriot and militia organizations. The tales spread like a prairie fire in a brisk wind, fueled by phone trees and reams of fax paper, the gasoline of the Militia of Montana, and the Patriot Fax Network. Cinders wafted high upon a fools breeze searching for tender ears to burn. Calls bombarded radio talk shows. The airwaves were rife with speculation and predictions of Armageddon. The smoke from these fires was fear. It hung low to the ground and gathered in pockets clouding minds and affecting judgement, it stank. The craziness reached its zenith, a conflagration, when a respected publication, 'Strategic Investment' Volume 10 Number 4 dated March 22, 1995, printed the following two paragraphs in the column 'Behind the lines', by Jack Wheeler:

"The slaughter of dozens of women and children in Waco by government stormtroopers under the command of Field Marshall Reno must pale in comparison to what has been planned for late March: a nationwide BATE/FBI assault on private militias as the prelude to a possible declaration of martial law throughout the United States. All leaves and vacations have been cancelled for BATE/FBI personnel, and for various State Police and National Guards such as California's. The Army's infamous Joint Task Force Six (which did the training for Waco) has been training BATE jackboots with Bradley Assault Vehicles at Ft. Bliss, Texas. Government agent provocateurs are set to plant fully automatic and heavy weapons like rocket launchers, on the property of militia leaders. Every militia in the country-and there are dozens, many of which are well-armed and well-led by former or even active-duty officers-is on a state of Red Alert. Should Reno be stupid enough to actually attack them militarily there is going to be a lot of blood."

"The establishment media is programmed to immediately thereafter thunderously follow for nationwide gun confiscation and even martial law. The Senate Armed Forces Committee has been alerted and is questioning key Defense and Justice people behind closed doors. Hopefully Reno's Waco can be stopped in time. But that it was plotted in the first place should be a sobering lesson as to what a horrifying extent liberalism, the political philosophy of the administration and the Democratic Party, has been converted into a close cousin of fascism."

The Editors of 'Strategic Investment' include Knight Templar the Rt. Hon. Lord Res-Ming of England's MI-6 and Knight Templar William E. Colby of the CIA amongst others. This publication and several others, 'Soldier of Fortune' comes to mind,

'The Conference of the States'

The Council of State Governments has called upon the fifty states to pass a resolution calling for a "Conference of States," to be held in October 1995, to be attended by a minimum of 350 delegates, to include 50 State Governors, and 300 state legislators, 6 for each state, as appointed by the Governors, to "develop a comprehensive action plan to restore balance in the federal system." The Council of State Governments has furnished the Governors and Legislatures of each state with an identical resolution which,

if passed, empowers the delegates to act in behalf of their state. Governor Benjamin Nelson of Nebraska (D) and Governor Michael Leavitt of Utah (R) are the official spokesmen for the Council of State Governments, for the promotion of what is now known as "The Conference of the States" (COS). A preliminary meeting of the delegates is scheduled in Chicago during July to set the agenda and the procedures for the second, which is scheduled to be held in Philadelphia the 22nd through the 25th of October, the 50th anniversary of the founding of the United Nations.

COS has been dubbed 'Philadel-

phia II'. It is a historic first formal gathering of the states since 1787. It enjoys broad, bipartisan support from state leaders. It is guided by a national, bipartisan steering committee of state elected officials, under the auspices of The Council of State Governments in cooperation with the National Governor's Association, the National Council of State Legislatures, and the Legislative Exchange Council.

History

At least two of these organizations, maybe all of them, are branches of the old Public Administration Clearinghouse (PAC) formally located at 1313 60th Street, Chicago, Illinois. You are not supposed to know that PAC is the true origin of the term 'PAC', an organization of persons or organizations for the purpose of introducing or promoting the passage of legislation for their mutual benefit or profit.

Correction: PAC was erroneously printed in issue #1 of Veritas as PAG. Please make this correction to your records and to your copy of issue #1. Please accept our sincere apology.

PAC was founded by the Rockefeller and Carnegie Foundations in 1930. Funding came from grants furnished by these same foundations. PAC is the organization that drafted the Presidential Proclamations of Franklin D. Roosevelt beginning on March 4, 1933, and the legislation H.R. 1491 named 'An Act To provide relief in the existing national emergency in banking, and for other purposes', all of which gave President Roosevelt dictatorial powers. H.R. 1491, as amended, gave blanket congressional approval to all Executive Orders issued by any President past, present, or future. This blanket approval effectively converted the office of the President to the office of the King. PAC has

evolved over the years into the Advisory Commission on Intergovernmental Relations (ACIR), the Council of State Governments (CSG), and the Committee on the Constitutional System (CCS). CCS is an organization which promotes the adoption of the parliamentary system of government by the United States and the several States. Do not let the word State confuse you. The Council of State Governments is an international organization with an international membership.

PAC, ACIR, and CSG have been the source of most of the legislation introduced and passed in the United States House and Senate, and both houses of all 50 State Legislatures since 1930. Much of this legislation has been Marxist in nature and antithetical to our American Constitutional form of government. For those of you who wondered where the 25,000+ pages of the General Agreement of the office of the President to the office of the King. PAC has

Citizens of the American Republic

For some time now, we who oppose the Conference of the States (COS) have done so on the basis that this COS is no ordinary national conference. Rather, we believe it is a precursor to a Constitutional Convention (Con-Con). We further believe a Con-Con at this time of dramatic change in our country is ill-advised and would effectively destroy many constitutional principles we find virtually sacred.

The proponents of the COS have steadfastly insisted a Con-Con is not their intention. However, there are many warning signals that would indicate otherwise. Previous writings by Utah Governor Michael Leavitt describe our federal government as "out-dated and old-fashioned" and "not suited to the fast-paced, high-tech, global marketplace we are entering." The various state resolutions being requested of the states specify that the bylaws of the COS will be "confined" to "fundamental, structural, long-term reforms" in government. We do not believe it is possible to explore these ideas without coming dangerously close to a Con-Con.

In addition, Article 1, Section 10 of our United States Constitution states, "No State shall, without the consent of Congress . . . enter into any Agreement or Compact with another State . . ." From this, it is clear the COS and the State's Petition, which is the stated goal of the COS, do represent an agreement or compact with other states, and as such are in direct violation of the Constitution barring consent of Congress.

On March 2, 1995, Senator Hank Brown introduced SR 82 in the U.S. Congress. This resolution laments Congress' inability to pass the Balanced Budget Amendment and, then, at the enacting clause of the Resolution, states, "Resolved, that Congress hereby petitions the several States of the United States of America to convene a Conference of the States for the express and exclusive purpose of drafting an Amendment to the Constitution of the United States requiring a balanced budget and prohibiting the imposition of unfunded mandates on the States to convene a Constitutional Convention pursuant to Article V of the Constitution of the United States in order to adopt such Amendment."

This resolution is believed to clearly represent the "consent of Congress" as required by Article 1, Section 10 of the Constitution. This consent document goes one step further, however, and lays the groundwork for a Con-Con.

The supporters of the COS can no longer say the intent of the COS is not to convene a Con-Con. We now have in plain language, for all to see, the preparatory steps to a Con-Con. Our worst fears for the dangers this COS represents to our Constitution are now real. The constitutional crisis represented by this COS must be opposed by all who revere the work of the Framers of our Constitution.

A Constitutional Convention at this point in our nation's history is not recommended because statesman of the caliber of Thomas Jefferson, John Adams, and Benjamin Franklin are not presently in national political leadership. Our nation has such people; each of us must seek them out and then provide the support to encourage these people to show themselves.

'Big Brother'

A reality in socialist Britain

The characters in George Orwell's '1984' would feel at home today in Great Britain. 'Big Brother is watching you', is no longer a warning of things to come. If a visitor gets the feeling that someone is watching do not chalk it up to paranoia. Big Brother is alive and well functioning just as Orwell described in many English cities.

Several teens walk along a street in King's Lynn, England. They pause, huddle against a wall, then dance away. One remains to plant his signature upon the brickwork. When he is finished he runs to catch his friends. Together they stride around the corner straight into the arms of the local Bobby. The policeman takes one teen, the exact boy who painted the wall, even though he did not see the crime committed. The lad is made to repair the damage, is thoroughly chastised then released. The Bobby waves upward toward the roof of a building across the street. If you look carefully you will see the video camera that recorded everything.

In the control room in a local office sits the security officer who witnessed the offense and described the offender to the Bobby. Pictures from 60 steerable video cameras flow into this room through fiber-optic cables laid by British Telecom. Through the eyes of these cameras every major public space in the city can be monitored every moment of every day.

No one complains about the surveillance. The city fathers cite the fact that since the cameras were installed the car-related crime rate has dropped significantly.

People may notice a camera here or there but for the most part they go unnoticed. No one seems to mind. Maybe the English are not aware of the extent of video surveillance in their cities. It is impossible today, in Great Britain, to venture outside without your image being recorded on several videotapes.

Spokesmen say that more than 300 local authorities are planning the introduction of video surveillance in their areas. "This is a friendly eye in the sky," said one from Liverpool. "There is nothing sinister about it." There is no argument for or against. There is no public debate at all. There is no legislation, not even a by-your-leave.

The only evidence that anyone is even watching is a request from the organization Liberty, formerly the National Council for Civil Liberties, for the government to introduce legislation to ensure that the cameras are only used for crime detection. "The innocent have nothing to fear," is the reply from the Home Office ministers.

The next project is a compulsory ID card. Not having one or failing to produce it on request an offense. Police would then have more grounds to stop people. The British who began the thrust toward Liberty seem to have wearied of it all.

Nations greeted the fall of the Soviet Union with cheers. The future looked good minus the threat of atomic war. The evil empire died, do you see that? While our eyes were on Russia and the Eastern Bloc, two new threats materialized, the economic power of the socialist European Union and Islamic militarism with its un-predicted alliances.

The European Union

In Europe geography has always determined history. Austria's accession to the European Union sets Hungary on the border. The EU finds itself sharing a common land border with Russia, now a direct neighbor due to the accession of Finland and Sweden. A new Scandinavian and Baltic dimension to what had been a predominantly Western European formation confronts the EU with its new challenges to the east.

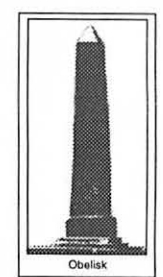
SYMBOLOLOGY

Ambassador signs treaty?

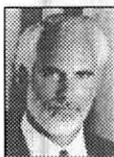

The "Plunging Dollar" Fact or Fiction?

□ A summary of John Dayl interviewing David Bradshaw on radio station KFYY, in Phoenix, Arizona on 3/11/95.

Introduction

The doomsayers were ecstatic. Wall Street bankers trembled. And America yawned. All because the value of the U.S. dollar slipped to record lows this week. Symbolically this signals an unhealthy loss of confidence in our president, our central bank and our ability to "manage our money." But is there more to the story? Where can we place our confidence?

J.D. What do you make of the recent tumble in the value of the U.S. dollar?

D.B. Let me preface our discussion about economics by saying to you and your listeners that I am not an economic expert - that is I don't have a PhD, a bow tie, or coke bottle glasses - therefore, I will probably never end up on Nightline. But, I have had the opportunity to read, study history and apply common sense. I agree with the philosopher

ford historian, the average person living in the Middle Ages in Europe worked an average of only 8 months a year, lived in a 10 room home, payed a maximum of 12-30% tax and shunned debt like the plague. So, really, how far have we really come. Perhaps that is one reason why modern economics is sometimes referred to as "the dismal science," or the "science of confusion."

Now, regarding the recent plunge in the U.S. dollar. Although it appears we are facing a financial crisis of confidence in the dollar, I believe it is a smokescreen for an even larger crisis - THE 20th CENTURY "PLUNGE IN THE DOLLAR" IS IN REALITY AN OXYMORON - THERE IS NO HONEST MONEY OR REAL "DOLLARS" IN CIRCULATION TODAY AT ALL! THEREFORE, A REAL DOLLAR CANNOT PLUNGE! BUT REAL MONEY HAS BEEN QUIETLY REPLACED WITH PSEUDO-DOLLARS, WHOSE VALUE FLOATS ON AN OCEAN OF DEBT IN A LEAKY BOAT CALLED "BLIND FAITH IN GOVERNMENT."

By definition a "dollar" is a unit of measurement or weight of precious metal - gold, silver or copper. In the Coinage Act of 1792 our founding fathers, after great discussion and thorough historical analysis, decided that the U.S. dollar would be defined as 24.7 grains of

Disraeli who said, "that the only thing that has driven more men mad than love is the currency question."

Most Americans are uneasily aware that something is wrong with our whole currency system that adversely affects the stability of our economy - but very few can identify the root cause. The problem is then complicated by inaccurate government statistics, confusing, and often contradicting statements from economic analysts, which is further compounded by the managed news media hype, as they continually chase the "crisis of the hour." Today news reporting has shifted from half-truths to NOT reporting the key issues at all!

The bottom line is that very few Americans are getting ahead financially and many are going backwards - despite an average of 2 1/2 jobs per household. The American dream seems illusive to many and the future appears even less hopeful. It may surprise your listeners to discover that despite the industrial and technical advances of the 20th century according to Thorold Rogers, an Ox-

pure gold, or 371 grains of pure silver, period. There never was to be an alternative.

Now, listeners put on your thinking cap for a moment. When you go to the grocery store to buy, say a gallon of milk, there are two elements: the measurement (a gallon) and the substance (the milk). Right? Likewise honest money or currency must have two elements: the measurement (a dollar weight) and the substance but wait a minute - WHAT IS THE SUBSTANCE OF TODAY'S DOLLAR? Gold? No. Silver? No. Then what is it? Sadly, I must report to you that it is NOTHING - unless you can call DEBT a substance. I don't think you can, and yet, debt is all that has backed the U.S. currency for over 30 years now. Ever since 1964, when our nation abandoned the use of silver as our substance, and 60 years, since 1933, when we abandoned the use of gold as our substance. Between 1792 and 1913 the cumulative inflation was a mere 16% - between 1913 and 1995 the cumulative inflation was over 1000%.

Omnibus Counterterrorism Bill

□ New FBI Charter to Investigate Political Groups

On February 10, 1995 the Omnibus Counterterrorism Bill was introduced as S. 390 in the Senate and as H.R. 896 in the House. Initiated by the FBI, and passed on by the Justice Department and the White House. Senators Biden (D-DE) and Specter (R-PA) initiated it in the Senate. Rep. Schumer (D-NY) and Dicks (D-WA) in the House. This bill may move quickly due to bipartisan support.

This bill will allow the FBI, military and other agencies to perform investigations on political groups at will. It will authorize secret trials for immigrants without being charged for a crime but rather who are accused of supporting lawful activity by organizations which may be accused of committing illegal acts. Immigrants can be deported using evidence they or their attorneys would never see, in secret trials, and with one sided appeals.

The definition of terrorism will be broadened. The President's determination of who is a terrorist will not be appealable.

- posse Comitatus will be suspended - allowing the use of the military to aid the police regardless of any other laws.

- Rules regarding wiretaps will be loosened.

- Accused will be ineligible for bail.

- If this bill is allowed to pass, the government may target organizations solely on their political beliefs. In closing, international terrorism does not include anything that is not already a crime.

A supply-side crime bill?

The crime bill of 1994 missed the mark badly like most of the bills that come out of Washington D.C. The main controversy of the bill centered around prevention programs and the assault gun ban. Funding for jails and police officers was universally embraced. Of the hundreds of speeches made by our representatives almost all totally missed the point of how foolish and ironic a federal crime bill is.

The war on crime has key parallels and ties to the war on drugs and the war on poverty. It doesn't take great powers of observation to have noticed the rise in violent crime in America over the last four decades. When the well intentioned policies of the Great Society tried to destroy poverty it damaged the family. It did this by removing the father from welfare families and making out-of-wedlock births not just tolerable but acceptable and profitable. This created a generation growing up with a lack of guidance and a diminished sense of responsibility. These criminals we are discussing are not immoral but amoral. Many of them rape, rob, and kill with no sense of remorse.

The parallel between the war on drugs and crime is the same losing strategy, and it has been failing for more than twenty years. Both have attacked the supply side and all but ignored the demand. Until we raise a generation who will mostly refuse drugs there will be a problem. The analogy being that we need to create a generation who will simply not consider criminal acts as an alternative to accomplish their goals. Reasonable people will not murder, rape, or attack innocents for any reason.

To instill conventional morality and responsibility in our youth cannot be done through the bill's elaborate baby-sitting schemes. The government has been sponsoring illegitimacy and has replaced the father in welfare families across the land, removing many of the consequences of reckless reproduction. Stop this welfare cycle and watch the nation straighten up. How long would this take? Probably about twenty years for good results. It took that long for things to start breaking down. The alternative is to continually expand prison space until (almost) everybody is locked up.

Banning assault weapons is a farce. Taking away the instrument of crime is typical of our national philosophy which views all problems as symptomatic instead of systemic. More than half of all gun murders are committed by hand guns compared to one percent for assault weapons. Knives account for more than ten times the number of deaths than assault weapons. Banning firearms, or cutlery for that matter, will not inspire criminals to change their ways. The gun is merely one tool of the trade for the criminal. They have many others.

Congress can't pass a law that makes criminals be nice, it can only punish after the fact. People who value education, truth, and family generally don't commit crimes. People with a strong work ethic generally don't commit crimes. People who believe in the golden rule generally don't commit crimes.

U.N. directed population control, Cairo and beyond

Conference of the States: "The Scenario"

"I have seen the future, and in it I have seen the end of our republic, and it is scheduled for October 1995 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania."

Please carefully read the following:

It is the summer of 1995.

For decades now, the U.S. Congress has continued to operate far beyond the enumerated powers defined for it in Article 1, Section 8 of the United States Constitution. Years and years of unconstitutional and unfunded mandates have brought the states to a boiling point. The Tenth Amendment Initiative started in 1994 by Senator Charles Duke of Colorado did ripple across the country, but to no avail. There seems to be no relief from the constant pressure of federal oppression. Following the lead of Governor Mike Leavitt of Utah and the Council of State Governments, over twenty-six of the states have passed resolutions calling for a "Conference of the States." The preliminary planning meeting for the conference takes place during the summer in Annapolis, Maryland where the by-laws are finalized and agenda items scheduled. Numerous amendments are added to the by-laws to satisfy those states concerned the conference may turn into a constitutional convention. The meeting place and dates are set. It will be held in Philadelphia in October. The dates are secured for the 22nd, a Sunday, thru the 25th.

It is now October 1995.

DAY ONE

The Conference of the States passes as expected. The delegations from all fifty states arrive at the Conference Chairman, Governor Leavitt of Utah, calls the conference to order and places the by-laws and other administrative rules into effect. There are several spirited discussions about states' rights and federal mandates.

DAY TWO

Begins with more heated debates. Frustration leads to questionable action at first, as the debate turns to drafting new amendments to the Constitution and then the rules are suspended by a vote that passes by a narrow margin. Someone moves to petition the U.S. Congress to convene a Constitutional Convention and offers a candidate petition right then and there! Several members of the delegations try to object but are ruled out of order (the rules are suspended, remember). The petition passes and is immediately transmitted to the United States Congress. Congress responds to the petition and under the authority of Article V of the Constitution declares the Conference of the States to be a Constitutional Convention AND simultaneously declares the Conference of the States to be CONCURRENTLY, a Ratifying Convention under the same Article V ("... when ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several states, OR BY CONVENTIONS ...") Congress returns authorization to Philadelphia within hours.

DAY THREE

The Supreme Court refuses to hear a brief quickly prepared to stop the runaway convention stating that the issues are "political" in nature and beyond the purview of the Court. (The Court relies on Coleman vs. Miller, 307 U.S. 433 (1939)) The Conference of the States, essentially a CON-CON, a Constitutional Convention, now in full stride, continues to propose "fundamental, structural and long term" changes (words taken literally from the resolutions passed in the state months) to our federal government (SR 12 in Pennsylvania; SCR 618, HCR 140), or HCR 781 in Florida; SCR 32 in Michigan as examples).

Legislators home in their various states are following events at the conference. They are confused as to how this apparent reversal of events could have happened. They had heeded the voices of concern and had amended their respective state resolutions with words they thought would protect against just such events as this happening. Words that had been provided to them by the Council of State Governments itself! If only they had understood that by empowering their delegations to act on behalf of "We the People", they had allowed to be created a sovereign body outside the Constitution. And that body was now empowered to create or destroy government itself. They had played "Russian Roulette" with our Constitution, and they had lost. IF ONLY THEY HAD AN OPPORTUNITY TO CAST THAT SEEMINGLY INSIGNIFICANT VOTE OVER AGAIN.

The debates back at the Conference of the States continue into the night as amendments are offered, debated, and ratified in a matter of hours. Years and years of frustration are vented while over two hundred years of our constitutional republic lies helpless on the surgeon's table. It is the end of DAY THREE, October 24, 1995. And while our nation contemplates the future of our republic, much of the rest of the world celebrates the Fourth Anniversary of the United Nations.

DAY FOUR

Dear Representative or Senator. Please complete the scenario for day four. The future events outlined above, while fictional, are absolutely possible and are based upon documented historical and current events, strict interpretation of the United States Constitution, Supreme Court case rulings, and the publicly stated motives of the Council of State Governments and Governor Leavitt of Utah, to name a few. Both have stated they want a Constitutional Convention and the CSG has even drafted revision to two amendments.

Ask yourself these questions: Why are all the states being asked to "empower" their delegations for this conference when the states meet routinely and discuss states' rights, troubles with the federal government, etc. without such formal empowerment? Why does this conference need power and what will it be used for? Why are state Representatives and Senators who oppose this being strong-armed and threatened by party leadership with loss of power, loss of WAMS (walk around money), etc. unless they support it? Don't forget your water

"Water, water everywhere, and not a drop to drink." This is the lament of all the cells of your body including your 15 billion brain cells that are 70 percent water. Next to oxygen, water is the most important substance in the body. Water is essential for all life and drinking the right amount is important to your health.

It has been said that 95 percent of Americans walk around in a dehydrated condition. The average adult body contains approximately 45 quarts (11 gallons) of water and loses about three and a half quarts daily in perspiration, respiration, urine and defecation. About half of your water losses can be replaced with the water content in your food. The remaining half requires specific fluid intake, primarily from drinking good water. Water has many purposes, the temperature of your body is controlled through water. Water makes up 92 percent of the blood of the body and nearly 98 percent of intestinal, gastric, saliva and pancreatic juices. Water is involved in almost every bodily function: circulation, digestion, absorption, and elimination of wastes, to name a few. Water carries the electrolytes, minerals that help conduct "electricity" in the body, such as electric currents that are needed for nerve impulses to occur. The proper amount of water helps to keep the cholesterol level down. One of the most important functions of water is to flush the toxins and salt from the body. Water is a great flushing agent to remove accumulated poisons which come into your body from the food you eat and the air you breathe each day.

When you drink a glass of water, it goes directly to your stomach. Part of the water is absorbed directly into your blood stream through the walls of the stomach. The remainder goes to the intestines to keep the food you eat in a liquid state while the food nutrients are being absorbed; this is later absorbed directly into the blood. Liquid is necessary for proper digestion of food.

Water is a vital factor in all body fluids, tissues, cells, lymph, blood and all glandular secretions; water holds all nutritive factors in solution and acts as a transportation media to various parts of the body; it holds toxins and body wastes in solution and again serves as a transportation medium of these substances; the mucous membranes need plenty of water to keep them soft and free from having friction on their delicate surfaces. Healthy, moist mucous membranes in your nose and lungs are a great barrier to the illness. The right kind of water is one of your best natural protection against all kinds of virus infections, such as influenza, pneumonia, and other infectious diseases.

Many people have that dehydrated look. Their skin looks parched, withered, dry and old. Look at the dry and withered hands of many people. Look at the wrinkles on the forehead and around the eyes. See how a curtain of dry flesh hangs over the eyes. Such people seem to squirt out of little bits to see. *Paul Bragg N.D., Ph.D., Life Extension Expert, has said, "In my long career as a nutritional and conditioner advisor to the greatest stars in films and TV, I have found that, when I can persuade the stars to use the correct liquids, they retain the ageless face, form and figure very much longer than the person who drinks ordinary amounts of water. Correct water keeps the body cells normal and prevents dehydration. The face and neck are more free of aging lines and wrinkles and the face and body retain the characteristics of youth longer. The right kind of water is nature's greatest beauty and health tonic." (1)*

How much water do you need to drink each day? The amount of water you need is based upon a number of factors—your size, your activity level, which influences the amount of fluid you lose through sweat; the climate or temperature (higher environmental temperatures increase your fluid losses); and your diet. A diet high in fruits and vegetables provides more total fluids through food than a diet high in fat, meat, and dairy products, for example. Special circumstances in which increased amounts of water may be needed include fever, diarrhea, kidney disease, or any situation where excessive fluid losses occur through normal body elimination processes. Generally, you can determine the amount of water you need to drink according to your

own body weight. You can use this simple mathematical formula. Weight yourself to find out your body weight. Now divide your weight by three and call this number ounces. For example, if you weigh 150 pounds, 150 divided by three would equal 50. Now call the number 50 "ounces"; so, you would drink a minimum of 50 ounces (6 cups) of water each day. The water you drink needs to be drunk in small amounts throughout the day to ensure a constant supply of fresh water to your cells. This 50 ounces of water needs to be pure, plain water.

Most people ask me, "Can I cook coffee or pop when I am calculating my water intake for the day, these drinks are made up of water?" The answer is you may drink other beverages besides water but these other beverages can't be considered in your water intake. Your body needs the proper amount of plain water each day. Caffeinated beverages, such as coffee, tea, cocoa, or colas, and alcoholic beverages do not count as the same volume of water because they act as diuretics in the body, increasing fluid losses from the kidneys. (2) So to get the minimum requirement of water don't count other beverages in your water intake.

What is meant by saying drink "pure" water? Aren't all waters pure? The tap water of many homes is polluted with chemicals, bacteria, parasites, fertilizer and insecticide residues. Other toxic substances that may be found in tap water are arsenic, asbestos, cadmium, and cyanides, which can combine with the other chemicals to form carcinogenic substances. (3) Most tap water needs to be purified by some method before drinking.

You can research for yourself what purification system you want to use to clean your water. I would suggest that you drink stream-distilled water for the first 90 days of a body cleansing program, then either continue the distilled water or start drinking water that has been filtered through a solid carbon block water filter, three granular carbon filters, reverse osmosis or a combination of filter water systems. When you purchase bottled water make sure the water comes from a reputable company.

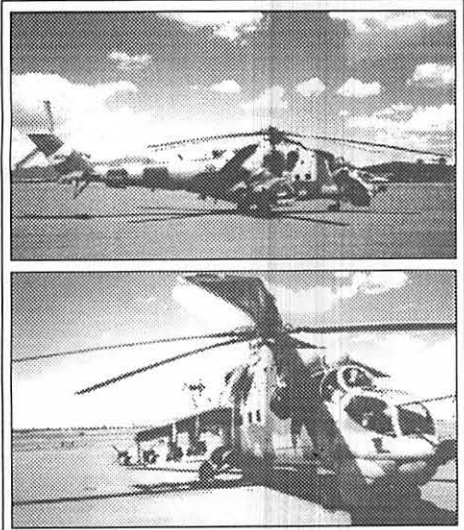
Why use distilled water when there are so many different types of filtered water being sold today? Distilled water is not only purified but it's "ionic," toxic free, and has the electro-chemical potential to break up heavy element deposits and flush them from the body. Heavy element deposits can lead to hardening of the arteries, high blood pressure, or kidney stones. Distilled water is very efficient in removing toxins and poison from the body which could make you sick and tired. (4)

Distilled water, contrary to what you may hear, will not leach out body minerals. Cellular minerals which are in use by the body are strongly bound to carbon (chelated) and this bond is very strong. Distilled water will, however, break up unwanted heavy element deposits and eliminate them as part of the detoxification process. (4)

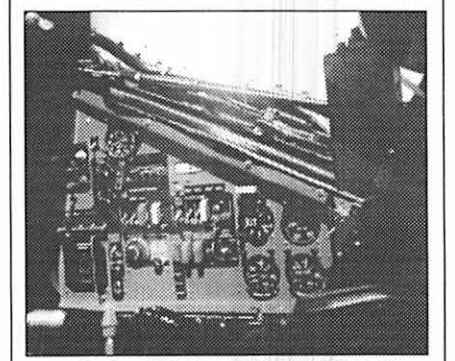
Another point to know is, the minerals that are in well water or mineral water are considered inorganic, which means they are not bound to a carbon molecule so they can not be used by the body to make good health. In fact, when you drink water that has inorganic minerals in it your body needs to go to extra work to remove the inorganic minerals from your body before they accumulate and make you sick. Realize the water that is inside of an apple is distilled water, rain water is distilled water, although it has pollutants from the air. There are many bits of information that can help you decide about the water you drink. Make sure you drink pure water.

Title 26, United States Code, Subtitle D, Chapter 38A, Section 4612(a)(4)(A) reads:
 "DEFINITIONS. - For the purposes of this subchapter . . . IN GENERAL. - The term 'United States' means the 50 States, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, any possession of the United States, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, and the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands."

Title 26, United States Code, Chapter 79, Section 7701(a)(9) reads:

Title 26, United States Code, Chapter 79, Section 7701(b)(1)(A-B) reads:


Title 26, United States Code, Subtitle A, Chapter 1A, Part I, Section 2(d) reads:
 "NONRESIDENT ALIENS. - In the case of a nonresident alien individual, the taxes imposed by sections 1 and 55 shall apply only as provided by section 871 or 877."

Title 26, United States Code, Subtitle A, Chapter 1N, Part II, Section 871(d)(1) reads:
 "ELECTION TO TREAT REAL PROPERTY INCOME AS INCOME CONNECTED WITH UNITED STATES BUSINESS.
 (1) IN GENERAL. - A nonresident alien individual who during the taxable year derives any income - (A) from real property held for the production of income and located in the United States, or from any interest in such real property, including (i) gains from the sale or exchange of such real property or an interest therein, (ii) rents or royalties from mines, wells, or other natural deposits, and (iii) gains described in section 631(b) or (c), and (B) which, but for this subsection, would not be treated as income which is effectively connected with the conduct of trade or business within the United States, may elect for such taxable year to treat all such income which is effectively connected with the conduct of a trade or business within the United States. In such case, such income shall be taxable as provided in subsection (b)(1) whether or not such individual is engaged in trade or business within the United States during the taxable year. An election under this paragraph for any taxable year shall remain in effect for all subsequent years, except that it may be revoked with the consent of the Secretary with respect to any taxable year."

Title 26, United States Code, Subtitle F, Chapter 61A, Part II, Section 6012(a) reads:
 "GENERAL RULE. - Returns with respect to income taxes under subtitle A shall be made by the following: . . . except that subject to such condition, limitations, and exceptions under such regulations as may be prescribed by the Secretary, nonresident individuals shall be subject to the tax imposed by section 871 and foreign corporations subject to the tax imposed by section 881 may be exempted from requirements of making returns under this section."

Title 26, United States Code, Subtitle C, Chapter 24A, Section 3402(p) reads:

The Crimes of Mena: Clinton and the Cult of Intelligence

The following are excerpts from an article by former National Security Council staffer Roger Morris and Sally Denton. This amazing story was scheduled to appear in the *Washington Post* on January 29 - after months of delay by the Clintons and the CIA cultists at the Post. However, in a last minute turnaround by the editor of the *Post*, the story was not published (see accompanying item from *The Sunday Telegraph*).

If the story ever makes headline news it is almost certain to bring down the Clinton presidency. Moreover, though, it threatens much more than a presidency - it exposes the total corrupt and debased nature of consecutive U.S. Administrations.

Of the many stories emerging from the Arkansas of the 1980s that was the crucible of the Clinton presidency, none has been more elusive - nor more ominous - than the specter of major drug smuggling, gunrunning and money laundering tracing to the tiny town of Mena, Arkansas, in the dense pine forests of the Ouachita Mountains some 150 miles due west of Little Rock.

Local Internal Revenue Service agent Bill Duncan, Arkansas State Police investigator Russell Welch, Arkansas Attorney General Winston Bryant, then-Congressman Bill Alexander and various other officials and citizens in the state all believed by the late 1980s that they had what Bryant termed "credible evidence" of the most serious criminal activity involving Mena between 1981 and 1986, crimes seemingly without acquiescence if not complicity of elements of the U.S. government. Mena's obscure International Airport they thought to be a base for Adler Beitman (Barry Seal), a self-confessed, convicted smuggler whose operations were said to be linked to the intelligence community, and who was murdered by Colombian assassins early in 1986 after Seal testified for the U.S. government in a prosecution of leaders of the Medellin drug cartel.

After 1987, Duncan, Welch and others pressed for a number of official investigations into the alleged Mena connection. To their mounting dismay and alarm, every inquiry would be inexplicably effectual or else stilled altogether, and their own careers damaged in the process, furthering their suspicions of higher-level collusion and cover-up - and in any case leaving the larger mystery of what had really happened in the

woods of western Arkansas. Now, however, a new mass of documentary evidence relating to Barry Seal has come to light, substantiating the worst suspicions about Mena as never before.

Gathered from various sources over the course of the past year, the more than 2,000 documents span the years 1981 - 1986, and include Seal's bank and telephone records; negotiable instruments, promissory notes and invoices; personal correspondence; address and appointment books; bills of sale for aircraft and parts; aircraft registration and modification work orders; personal diaries, handwritten "to do" lists and other private notes; secretly tape-recorded conversations; cryptographic keys and legends for codes used in the Seal operation; numerous depositions and other sworn statements - and, not least, extensive official records, including federal investigative and surveillance reports, accounting assessments by the IRS and Drug Enforcement Agency, and previously unreported court testimony as well as confidential pre-sentencing memoranda in federal narcotics trafficking trials in Florida and Nevada.

Startling Evidence
Among only a few of its revelations, the Seal Archive provides documentation:

- That Mena, Arkansas from 1981 to 1986 was indeed one of the centers of an international smuggling traffic, amounting, by official IRS and DEA calculations, sworn court testimony and other corroborative records - to many thousands of pounds or kilos of cocaine and heroin, and literally hundreds of millions of dollars in drug profits.
- That Seal himself spent hundreds of thousands at the Mena airport to land, base, maintain and specially equip or refit his aircraft for smuggling. According to personal and business records, he had extensive associations locally at Mena and in Little Rock, and was in nearly constant telephone contact with Mena when he was not there himself, including repeated calls just before the day of his murder in 1986.
- That as a former member of the U.S. Army's Special Forces, Seal had ties to the Central Intelligence Agency dating to the early 1970s. He had confided to relatives and others, according to their sworn statements,

that he was a CIA operative before and during the period of the Iran-contra episode, and that he was establishing his operations at Mena.

- That Federal Aviation Administration registration records confirm that aircraft officially identified or admitted to be in the Seal smuggling operation at Mena and elsewhere were previously owned by Air America, Inc., a known CIA "proprietary" company. Emile Camp, one of Seal's pilots and a witness to some of his most significant dealings, was killed on a mountainside near Mena in 1985, in the unexplained crash of one of those planes previously belonging to Air America.

- According to still other Seal records, at least some of the aircraft of his smuggling fleet, which numbered a Learjet, helicopter, and former U.S. military transports, were also outfitted with avionics and other equipment by yet another company in turn linked to Air America.

- That among the aircraft flown in and out of Mena was Seal's C-123K cargo plane, christened *Fat Lady*. The records show that *Fat Lady*, serial number 54-0679, was sold by Seal months before his death. According to still other files, the plane soon found its way to a "phantom company" that had become known in the Iran-contra scandal as "The Enterprise," the CIA-related enterprise managed by then - Col. Oliver North and others to smuggle illegal weapons to the Nicaraguan contra rebels, and according to former Drug Enforcement Agency agent Celerino Castillo and others, allegedly involved as well in return traffic in cocaine, profits from which were then used to finance more clandestine gunrunning.

- Federal aviation records show that in October, 1986, the same *Fat Lady* from Mena, serial number 54-0679, was shot down over Nicaragua with a load of arms destined for the contra. The doomed aircraft was co-piloted by a Wallace Blaine (Buzz) Sawyer who was himself from Magnolia in western Arkansas and who died in the crash. It was the long surviving crew member in that downing, Eugene Hasenfus,

whose admission of covert activity began a public unraveling of the Iran-contra episode.

- That hundreds of millions in profits generated by the Seal trafficking via Mena and elsewhere resulted in extraordinary banking and business practices in apparent efforts to "launder" or disperse the vast illicit money in Arkansas and elsewhere. The Seal financial records show for the early 1980s, for example, instances of daily deposits of \$50,000 or more, and extensive use of an offshore, foreign bank in the Caribbean as well as financial institutions in Arkansas and Florida. (On October 9, the *London Sunday Telegraph* reported independently the existence of "numerosous" other foreign bank accounts in Seal's name, including one said to contain over a billion dollars.)

- That Seal was scarcely alone in his extensive smuggling through Mena and elsewhere over the period 1981 - 86, commonly described in both federal and state law enforcement files among the Seal papers as one of the largest drug trafficking operations in the U.S. at the time, if not in the history of the drug trade. He was "only the transport," documents show Seal confiding on one occasion, pointing to an extensive network of narcotics distribution and finance in Arkansas and other states. As one example, the Seal records show him to have been a close associate of a group eventually prosecuted for major narcotics trafficking in neighboring Kentucky.

- That in explicit recognition of Seal's extraordinary significance in the drug trade - and thus of the magnitude and importance of Mena as one of his main bases - U.S. government prosecutors made him their chief witness in a 1985 Miami trial in absentia of Medellin drug lords, in another 1985 trial of what federal officials regarded as the largest case to date in Las Vegas, Nevada, and in still a third prosecution of corrupt officials in the Turks and Caicos Islands. At the same time, court records and other documents reveal a studied indifference by government prosecutors to Seal's earlier and ongoing operations in Mena.

The Barry Seal files are vindication for dedicated officials in Arkansas and others who kept an all-too-authentic story alive amid indifference. What happened to some nine different official investigations into Mena after 1987, from allegedly compromised federal grand juries to congressional inquiries suppressed by the National Security Council in 1988 under Ronald Reagan, to still later Justice Department inaction under George Bush?

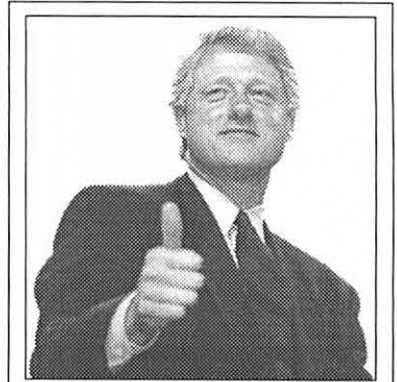
Officials apparently invoked "national security" to quash most of the investigations. Court documents do show clearly that the CIA and DEA employed Seal in 1984 - 85 for the Reagan administration's celebrated "sting" attempting to implicate the Nicaraguan Sandinista regime in cocaine trafficking.

Having assessed Seal posthumously for some \$86 million in back taxes on his huge smuggler's earnings from Mena and elsewhere between 1981 and 1983, as his tax records show, even the IRS forgave hundreds of millions in known drug

and gun profits over the ensuing two-year period when Seal was in effect moonlighting for the U.S. government. . . . Worked for the DEA/ CIA, an IRS agent noted pointedly across one of the papers in a file on Seal's taxes.

But to follow the IRS logic, what of the years, crimes and profits at Mena in the early 1980s before Barry Seal became an acknowledged federal operative, and then reported drug trafficking activities at Mena even after his murder, crimes far removed from his admitted cooperation as government informant and witness? Government investigators apparently had no doubt about the scope and magnitude of those crimes. According to U.S. Customs sources, Seal's operations at Mena and other bases were involved in the export of guns to Bolivia, Argentina and Brazil as well as the contra, and the importation of cocaine from Colombia to be sold in New York, Chicago, Detroit, St. Louis and other cities, as well as in Arkansas itself.

lower level federal or state law enforcement officers looking into the crimes of Mena found themselves stymied by the apparent presence of the CIA or other government involvement. "Joe [deleted] works for Seal, and cannot be touched because Seal works for the CIA," as one U.S. Customs official put it in an Arkansas investigation in the early 1980s. "... A CIA or DEA operation is taking place at the Mena airport," an FBI telex advised the Arkansas State Police in August, 1987, 18 months after Seal's assassination.

Significantly, none of the putative inquiries into Mena seems to have made a serious effort to gather even a fraction of the available Seal documents now assembled and studied by the authors.

In over 2,000 documents reflecting intimately a man of meticulous organization and planning, careful about every detail, Barry Seal seems to have felt singularly and utterly secure - if not somehow invulnerable - at least in the air transport and delivery in the U.S. of tons of cocaine, done ceaselessly for more than five years. His most personal papers show him all but unconcerned about the very high and drops, say law enforcement sources, that would indeed have been protected or "fixed" by the collusion of U.S. intelligence.

If the Seal documents show anything, an attentive reader might conclude, it is that ominous implication of some official sanction. Over the entire episode looms the unmistakable dark shape of U.S. government complicity in vast drug trafficking and gunrunning, and in a decade-long cover-up of the criminality.

Clinton's Involvement
Finally, of course, there are some questions about then - Gov. Bill Clinton's own role vis-a-vis the crimes of Mena. He has acknowledged learning officially about Mena only in April, 1988, though a state police investigation of Mena, reportedly amounting to thousands of pages, had been in progress for several years and as the state's chief executive Clinton was customarily abreast of such inquiries. In his one public statement on the matter as governor in September, 1991, he spoke of that state police investigation finding "linkages to the federal government" and "all kinds of questions about whether he [Seal] had any links to the CIA ... and if that backed into the Iran-contra deal."

But then, inexplicably, Clinton did not at any time seize on the issue or offer further support for any inquiry, "despite the fact," as Bill Plante and Michael Singer of CBS News have written, "that a Republican administration was apparently sponsoring a contra aid operation in his state and

protecting a smuggling ring that flew tons of cocaine through Arkansas."

Moreover, what of the hundreds of millions generated by Seal's Mena contraband? The Seal records reveal his dealings with at least one major Little Rock bank. How much drug money from him or his associates made its way into criminal laundering in Arkansas's notoriously free-wheeling financial institutions and bond houses, some of which are reportedly under investigation by the Whitewater Special Prosecutor for just such large, unaccountable infusions of cash and unexplained transactions? "The state offers an enticing climate for traffickers ... IRS agents had concluded by the end of the 1980s, documented by a "major increase" in the amount of large cash and bank transactions in the state after 1985, despite a struggling local economy.

Meanwhile, others who were prominent backers of Clinton over the same years have themselves been subjects of extensive investigative and surveillance files by the DEA and FBI similar to those relating to Seal. "This may be the first president in history with such close buddies who have NADDIS numbers," say one concerned law enforcement official, referring to the Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Intelligence System numbers assigned those under protracted investigation for possible drug crimes. The Seal documents seem still more proof that for Clinton, the Arkansas of the 1980's, and the company he kept there, will not soon disappear as a political or even constitutional liability.

"I've always felt we never got the whole story there ... " Clinton said in his 1991 statement on Mena. Indeed. But as president of the United States, he need no longer wonder - and neither does the nation - on the basis of the Seal documents (copies of which are being given to the Whitewater Special Prosecutor in any case), the president should ask immediately for a full report on the matter from what is now the CIA, DEA, FBI, Justice Department and other relevant agencies of his own administration, including the long-buried evidence gathered by Duncan and Welch. Clinton should also offer full evidence breach cooperation with a re-opened congressional inquiry, and expose the subject fully, for what it says of both our past and future.

As for Seal, he saw himself as a patriot to the end. He had dictated his own epitaph for his grave in Baton Rouge: "A rebel adventurer the likes of whom in previous days made America great."

In a sense, his documents may now render that claim less ironic than it seems.

Marxist 'New Left' dominates American colleges

Politics have taken a deciding turn to the right. Conservatism, whatever that is, has claimed victory across the board. Liberals are in retreat. Marxism is dead everywhere in America. Everywhere except on college campuses.

Dr. Gisela Dibble was born in Germany during the last days of Hitler's Third Reich. Caught when the Iron Curtain descended, she grew up in communist East Germany. When her family fled to the United States in 1953 she thought she had escaped totalitarianism. She was wrong. After having experienced the horror of fascism and Marxism, Dr. Dibble was denied a tenured position at the University of Maryland because, as the chairman of her department put it, she was "not suitable" for the position because she was "not a Marxist."

Dibble has filed a \$1-million discrimination suit in federal court against the University of Maryland at Baltimore County and her former supervisors. The suit charges that "plaintiff was denied academic freedom by the defendants when she refused to prostitute her academic teaching skills, knowledge and be-

liefs and her admiration for Western Culture - to adopt the cult of what is known in academic circles as the 'New Left'."

From 1983 to 1992, she taught German at UMBC for the Modern Languages and Linguistics department. She was a part and full-time lecturer. The Dr. claims that she was told in 1984 by John Sinnigen, department chairman, that "only a person with a Marxist background will be hired for the job" so she would be wasting her time applying.

Dibble also claims she was told by Sinnigen that only a candidate with "a Ph.D. in hand" would be eligible for the tenure position. She was only a short time away from her doctorate from University of Maryland-College Park.

When the position was awarded, however, it went to Edward Larkey, a man also without his Ph.D. "in hand." In her suit Dibble states that since he lacked a Ph.D. she could not have been refused the position on that ground. Therefore she must have been denied the post because of her academic beliefs, specifically, her anti-Marxism. Her claim takes on credibility when one learns that Larkey earned his Ph.D. from Humboldt University in what was then communist East Germany.

The suit was preceded by a letter sent by her attorney to the president of the University charging discrimination, that she'd suf-

fered "eight years of abusive and harassing treatment" within the UMBC system. After she submitted her complaint to the University in 1991, her part-time lecturer's contract was not renewed for the following year. That's when Dr. Gisela Dibble decided to sue the University of Maryland.

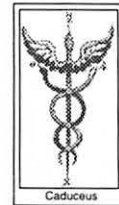
Maryland Assistant Attorney General Anne Donahue says that the state intends to file a motion for summary judgment to dismiss the case. "We deny any sex discrimination ever occurred. We deny that any free speech was violated," says Donahue. "We deny that any other discrimination occurred. If there are any I've left out, we deny those too."

The tenured professors refused comment. Those who know the academic world of America's college campuses tell us that "it is a world in which personalities and politics often play a more dominant role than scholarship or achievement." Jonathan Knight, associate secretary of the American Association of University Professors admits, "One person's ideology is another's balanced presentation." Students reveal, "No Marxism, no grade, no future."

and self productive while having no needs of dependency — true freedom. Pictures depicting the Garden of Eden show the serpent wrapped around the tree. When you see celebrating Christmas, you decorate your tree with lots of "Balls", all very colorful and you hang red and white striped caps, canes, the red stripe, like the red rose is the excited bloodflowing sexual force around a white colored stripe of purified desire, virgin innocence and truth. We see this red and white stripes on the barber-pole; on the pair of entry towers to the gates of castles in old Europe; on the spear that Saint George used to kill the dragon; all over India on all of the Hindu and Buddhist temples; on the two spiraling columns as you enter the main door to



the Vatican; and many other places. The medical symbol of the caduceus is known by many names in world mythology and is briefly, a center column or obelisk called the satsumora and it has 32 steps (symbol of the 32 lower degrees of Freemasonry). Around this center shaft are two serpents, the Ida (sun, white, right hand, positive, etc.) and the Pingala (moon, red, left hand, negative, etc.). The medical anatomy of the male phallus is a similar symbol, (center serpent or penis when excited becomes the rod (as of Moses, etc.) or the rules or straight-edge. The two testicles of all men hang thusly, the left (the negative side) always hangs lower than the right testicle (positive side). Thus the right hand of God or rather right hand writing is always encouraged in our schools as positive. The phallus is the first trinity. Jesus on the cross represents the center pillar of the caduceus or obelisk and on his sides were two thieves (testicles?). The one on his right asked for forgiveness and was rose "up" to God; the thief on his left did not ask for forgiveness and he sank "down" to hell. At the top of the caduceus is the 33rd step (highest degree in all Freemasonry) and is called the winged sun, which carries the enlightened Jesus and the right hand side ex-thief up to heaven, symbolized by the sun of God in our pure blue sky.

Similarly, the caduceus or obelisk is seen in our human bodies as the spinal column which has 32 sections and the skull, the 33rd and highest section (33 degrees of Freemasonry and the final age of Christ at his rising). The two serpents of the caduceus each spiral clockwise (Ida) and counterclockwise (Pingala) 1/2 times around this center column (satsumna or spinal column). They both as a total cross the center column 7 times and these 7 crossings are energy centers of the spinal area called chakras. As the serpents crawl up the shaft or obelisk, they rise through the 7 energy centers and break through their seals (as the 7 seals of the book in Revelation; and the back of the books are called the spine) to reach what is the Lux (light) or enlightenment and are carried off by the outfolded wings of the top of the caduceus (symbolized by the left and right sides of our brain folded out in flight of creative thought) flying to heaven.

Similarly, at the top of the obelisk is a point and at the end of the phallus (penis) is a point, where the force of creation or recreation is released during sexual union. The obelisk was a most sacred object to the ancient Egyptians, a symbol of their Sun god, Ra, and said to portray a petrified sunray. The pyramid or small pyramid at the top was the most sacred portion of the obelisk. It represented the cosmic mound of creation (the phallus). It would appear that although the ancient Egyptian priests (Freemasons) worshipped various gods, that even then they were seeking the one (1) true god with each of us, the phallus, creative, generative, energy and force of creation.

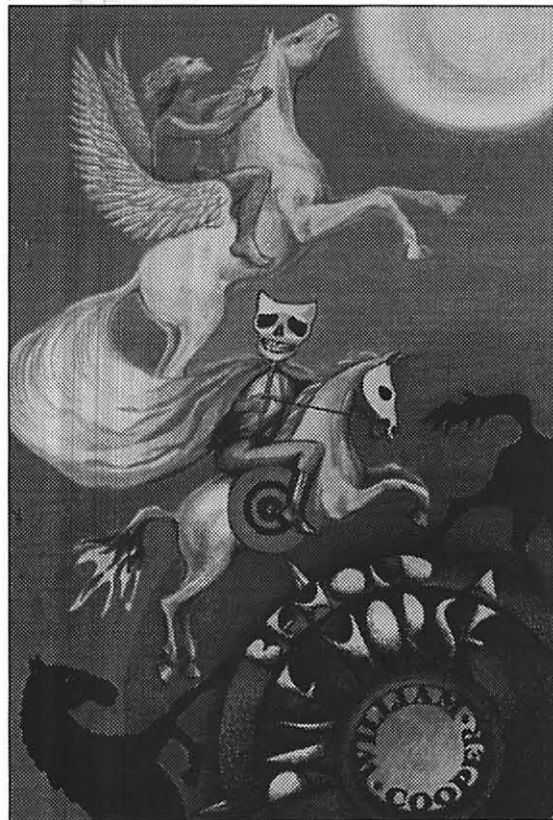

ment on Trade and Tariffs (GATT) came from, this is the source. Your elected representatives very seldom, if ever, write legislation. Legislation is provided to your representatives, state and federal, by these special interest groups, already written in final form along with a carefully written summary designed solely to promote its passage. Worse is the fact that most of the legislation provided to congress and state legislatures is not read by anyone. GATT is a prime example of the rubber stamp process at work. Most Presidential Executive Orders originate by the same process.

Since 1974 these organizations have promoted a "Constitutional convention." By 1983, 32 states had passed Resolutions calling for the "Con-Con." But the American people were never consulted. Most of the remaining states have not been able to promote enough interest to introduce the legislation. The few that have cannot get the resolution out of committee. And 3 of the original 32 that passed the Con-Con have rescinded their Resolutions. The effort to convene a Constitutional Convention has failed.

The Resolution

The originators of COS wish you to believe that the idea is a natural evolution of the 10th Amendment Resolution movement that was first introduced by State Senator Charles Dutz (R, Colorado). The 10th Amendment Resolution is a measure introduced to state legislatures, and if passed, "instructing the United States Government to conform to the limits on federal powers expressed by the Tenth Amendment." The very obvious problem with this Resolution is that it has no active clause and therefore has no force of Law. It is also obvious that if the federal government will not accept the limits placed upon it by the Tenth Amendment, the Supreme Law of the Land, the Constitution for the United States of America, it is certainly not going to bow to a resolution by the states. And this is exactly the reasoning used to justify the call for a Conference of States in the model resolution being promoted by the Council of State Governments.

- WHEREAS, the United States constitution established a balanced compound system of governance and through the Tenth Amendment reserved all nondelegated and nonprohibited powers to the states or to the people; and...
- WHEREAS, persistent, state-led endeavors have consistently failed to generate any substantial reaction or remedy from the federal government; and...
- WHEREAS, the United States Supreme Court has repeatedly determined that the states must look to the Congress and related political remedies for protection against federal encroachments on the reserved powers of the states; and...
- WHEREAS, the Council of State Governments, through its Inter-governmental Affairs committee, has been the champion of state sovereignty for many years, and a steering committee has been established as a primary catalyst to convene the Conference of the States; and...

Every good salesman develops the ability to inject a sense of urgency into his sale. A feeling that passing up the offer now will cause a great future loss. The authors of the Conference of the States Resolution did not miss this trick. It is intended to hurry the resolution to passage before the public catches on to its real purpose.

- WHEREAS, the Council of State Governments recognizes a sense of urgency in calling for a Conference of the States, whereby each state government would send a delegation to a States' petition and comprehensive action plan to restore balance in the federal system; and...
- WHEREAS, the Council of State Governments injected the necessary measures needed to cause the state legislatures to allow CSG to maintain the control it must have to guide the COS to its ultimate hidden purpose, a Constitutional Convention.
- WHEREAS, the aforementioned experience of the Council of State Governments, in conjunction with its regional structure and groupings of elected and appointed officials from all three branches of state government, reflects an entity ideally suited to promote and facilitate such a conference; and...

In paragraph 2 of the body of the resolution the purpose is addressed as, "...propose, debate, and vote on elements of an action plan to restore checks and balances between the states and the national government. Measures agreed upon will be forwarded to a national convention to be held in the fall of 1995, and the delegation's state for consideration by the entire legislature." Who could find fault? But in the very next paragraph, #3, we reach the first obvious revelation of an unconstitutional malevolent intent.

- (3) The conference of the States shall be convened under the section 501 (c)(3) auspices of the Council of State Governments in cooperation with the National Governors Association and National Conference of State Legislatures no later than 270 days after at least 26 legislatures adopt a resolution.

What you just read is illegal, unlawful, and blatantly unconstitutional. The laws governing 501 (c)(3) corporations forbid any engagement, no matter how slight, in political matters, state or federal. Further, the Constitution for the United States of America, Article I Section 10 par. 3 states: "No State shall, without the consent of Congress... enter into any Agreement or Compact with another State, or with a foreign Power..." So unless the Conference of the States has been granted the "consent of Congress," or has been promised same, this constitution is unconstitutional and therefore illegal and unlawful. In fact, it is a conspiracy. All of these points could make the instigators and all participants criminals. Are we expected to believe that these people would risk prison just to "propose, debate, and vote on elements of an action plan..." that is "formalized in an instrument called a States' Petition..."?

- (5) The bylaws shall: (c) specify that the conference agenda be limited to fundamental, structural, long-term reforms.

The above provision of the resolution finally hints at the truth. It clearly indicates that COS intends to attempt to manipulate the "fundamental, structural, long-term..." which can only be translated to mean Amendments to the Constitution, or a complete restructuring of the Constitution, or its replacement with something entirely new. The bylaws are a long-term, far-reaching program of the government can only be found in the Constitution for the United States of America. It can be found in no other place.

Nuda Veritas

This is exactly the same manner in which delegates from 7 states, a simple majority, met in Philadelphia in 1787 to "make structural changes in the relationship between the states and the federal government." The "changes" ended up scrapping the Articles of Confederation and imposing the Constitution. The states did not know this would happen, indeed, the delegates did not know this would happen. At least not in the way you see it today. It was told, had absolutely nothing to do with anything that happened leading up to, or during, the 1787 Constitutional Convention. We were lucky then. The Founding Fathers, realizing how easy it had been to change our government, warned us never to allow another Constitutional Convention. The Council of State Governments, are using the same con today to promote a double con. We must not allow this to happen.

Utah's Governor Mike Leavitt and Governor Ben Nelson of Nebraska lead the charge for the COS. In April, 1994, the Salt Lake Tribune reported a position statement on the conference released by Governor Leavitt stating, "On Thursday, the governor unveiled a proposal to gather support for an amendment to the U.S. Constitution giving states authority equal to the federal government's. He took his plan for an informal states' conference and a possible constitutional convention to the Western States Summit in Phoenix." (Emphasis mine.) He is talking about a Parliamentary system to replace the Constitution.

COS is set up so that it will meet in Philadelphia, which is necessary in a historical context, with only 26 delegates, again a simple majority, in attendance. Once these delegates meet, they only need to make a motion to suspend the rules and it is a whole new ball game. A motion to petition the Congress for approval to draft a Balanced Budget Amendment. The motion could be introduced. If this motion passed and was presented to Congress that day, the consent could be given by the following day, and the Conference of States would then be a Constitutional Convention convened for the purpose of drafting a Balanced Budget Amendment. Several prominent jurists, and 3 Supreme Court Justices have made it clear that, once convened, there are no limits set upon what a Constitutional Convention can do. This is devious and unconstitutional, to be sure, but it would be de-jure to George Washington, Ben Franklin, and Thomas Jefferson.

Could it be done? It already has been done. Senators Brown and Helms submitted Senate Resolution 82 to the 104th Congress, 1st Session, which

An anti-American alliance is taking form. CAJI and IS members in Brussels, Rome, London, Moscow, and Zurich report a new European-Russian compact that would destroy the U.S. economy.

An economic-military alliance between the European Union and Greater Russia will be the biggest challenge ever faced by the United States. The consequences of power will be the greatest in the history of the world. This combination seeks total domination just as Hitler's Nazi Germany did in the early forties. Hitler, however, never dreamed of the strength that would be embodied in this EU/Russian pact.

Russia

The world trembled during the attempted (staged?) coup against Gorbachev. The use of tanks, exactly, would take his place, coupled with the blurred danger of the Soviet Unions nuclear warheads was enough to worry even the most jaded. It is time to tremble again? Boris Yeltsin is not going to remain President for long. Who will succeed him? That is one of the most important questions in world politics today. Everyone has heard of Boris Yeltsin, but very few could tell you the name of any other leading political figure in Moscow. The old guard is passing. Some have heard of Vladimir Zhirinovskiy. Names like Boris Nemtsov, Yegor Gaidar, Alexander Rutskoi, Grigori Yavlinskii, and Boris Fyodorov draw only vacant stares.

Russia's economy demands special attention. It is not as bleak as you have been told. High risk is the norm but, as anywhere else, high risk means high rewards. Car ownership has gone up by 30 percent. The average monthly salary rose, in dollars, from \$18 in 1992 to \$113 in October of 1994. Despite the doomsayers, the Russian people are doing better economically than anyone can remember. Their problems lie in the areas of crime and education, particularly relating to business.

Russia's trade with the West is dominated by the European Union. The bulk, however, is still with other former Soviet republics. The European Unions exports to Russia were five times higher than those of the United States, and the imports were about 19 times higher from

Russia than the US. Russia's Central Bank granted full license to Citibank, Chase Manhattan, credit Suisse, ING Bank, ABN-AMRO, Société Générale, Bank of China, Yapa Ve and Bank Austria to compete with Dresdner BNP, and Credit Lyonnais, who already held licenses for business in St. Petersburg. Chechnya is the Achilles heel in Russia's political and economic future. The use of military might to solve a political problem is drawing fire from the leaders of the West, Americans in particular. Yeltsin's inability to solve the problem may be his downfall. His orders are sometimes ignored by his commanders. Some units have refused to fight. One General submitted his resignation. It was refused and he was transferred to a more peaceful post. There must be a solution and it must come soon. Chechnya is Russia's Kuwait. The main pipeline from the Caspian Sea oil wells comes inland through the oil pipelines of Grozny. It then forks, one pipeline goes west to the Black Sea and the Russian naval base at Novorossiisk, and the other heads north into Russia.

The two east-west railroad lines from Moscow to Makhachkala, strategically vital to any Russian military presence in the Caucasus, run through Chechnya. And so do the main roads. Without control of the territory, Russia could no longer sustain its forces or its trade in its least stable, most volatile region. That is why Yeltsin cannot let go of this country. Look for possible U.N. peacekeeping troops in Chechnya using US troops. Its far out, but if it happens you could anticipate U.N. peacekeeping in the US using Russian troops.

The Muslims in all of this seem to be the Soviet Unions nuclear arm. What of the atomic and hydrogen weapons that were poised for launch against the United States. Who controls them, if anybody? who is keeping tabs on the components to make the bombs? How do we know they are not being sold to gang-bangers in Los Angeles? Some say that the long and short-range weapons, nuclear missiles and submarines, of the old Soviet Union are the greatest threat to the world since the Cuban Missile Crisis. Reports say there are anywhere from 0 to as many as 35,000 atomic and hydrogen weapons floating around over there. If they don't exist, which is probable, why were we threatened with them for so many years? If they do exist, and in the larger numbers, are they being sold to the highest bidder in some way in nuclear war? And how do we find out? And even if they are not you must remember that Vladimir Zhirinovskiy threatened to use Russia's nuclear weapons against Japan, Germany, and America. Don't dismiss this guy as just another nut, he won the 1993 drama elections.

The Middle East

The Middle East is the easiest shot to call. The fires of Islamic extremism throughout the world have been fueled by the collapse of communism. I believed our forefathers died to gain liberty for themselves and their heirs. I believed we went through two world wars to preserve this liberty. I believed we did this to make certain that enemies from other governments would never touch us this, the most precious of all gifts. I am sorry to say, I believe it is time for actions once again to preserve our freedom. We have to begin by peacefully fighting our enemies from within time they are within our own government.

Senate Resolution 82

1. "Resolved, that Congress hereby petitions the several
2. States of the United States of America to convene a Conference of the States for the express and exclusive purpose
3. of drafting an Amendment to the Constitution of the
4. United States requiring a balanced budget and prohibiting
5. the imposition of unfunded mandates on the States, and
6. that such States then consider whether it is necessary for
7. the States to convene a Constitutional Convention pursuant to Article V of the Constitution of the United States
8. in order to adopt such Amendment."

"House of Governors"

Let us break this down, line by line, according to an assessment made by Marshall Peters. Mr. Peters has been studying the Conference of the States issue from its inception. He has furnished us with the following analysis based upon the points in last week's Veritas. The analysis is as follows. His points are numbered according to the line to which it pertains.

1. The Conference of States proceeds by "process amending", proposing an Article V Amendment amending the amending device: attempt of the Advisory Commission on Intergovernmental Relations (Art. V proposal 1989), with variations which are set forth in the Committee on the Constitutional System Director James Sundquist's proposal in "Constitutional Systems and Effective Governance," Vol. 24, No. 3, 343-344. "A simplified amendment procedure would never be considered in the abstract, simply as a theoretical proposition in the interest of good government. To win any significant backing, it would have to be seen as making the course easier for one or more specific, popular amendments whose supporters could then be mobilized by it."
2. The Conference of States creates an entity designated as that which is to be empowered to hold proposed amendments and decide to propose Constitutional Conventions. This entity is called COS and best described as formalizing a Parliament of Governance, a.k.a. House of Governors (HOG). See *The Great Events by Famous Historians*, copyright 1914 and 1919 by The National Alumni ("An association of college men," Vol. XXI (A.D. 1910-1914). "The House of Governors," pp. 1-31).
3. COS a.k.a. HOG's entity is to draft an amendment requiring a Balanced Budget, amend the amending device, to pull the wagon of revolutionary plans, using this as a thesis.

4. COS a.k.a. HOG's entity is to draft an amendment prohibiting unfunded mandates, a second draft horse, to pull the same wagon using this as an antithesis.
5. Synthesis embraces several goals, formalizing the House of Governors (COS), breaking open the amending device, and others. One among which would be for another amending purpose, that these respective mandates are being formed to imply socialist spending, thereby becomes constitutional in order to be funded with heavier taxation, via a Balanced Budget Amendment.
6. Wagon's occupant is HOG's entity, COS, which could then exercise power to decide whether to convene a convention, or conceivably, simply declare itself to be one, HOG's entity, or creature, is being implemented by a tour de force, a method "outside the U.S. Constitutional process." A tour de force method of amendment is one which is not within, or under, the U.S. Constitution's Article V; rather that revision process set and revised by process as designated in S. Res. 82; that which is now being created by a step by step process which is best described as "determined by HOG."

Implied is the involving of the public in vox populi, vox Dieu, appearing the revolution using media to keep all eyes on the horses while the wagon load. The synthesis is contained by HOG, the theater play is a distraction to pull the hidden wagon, while others watch a directed and orchestrated parade of the Balanced Budget Amendment-Unfunded Mandates Amendment, two workhorses pulling the wagon filled with HOG and the long sought Article V Court of Elders.

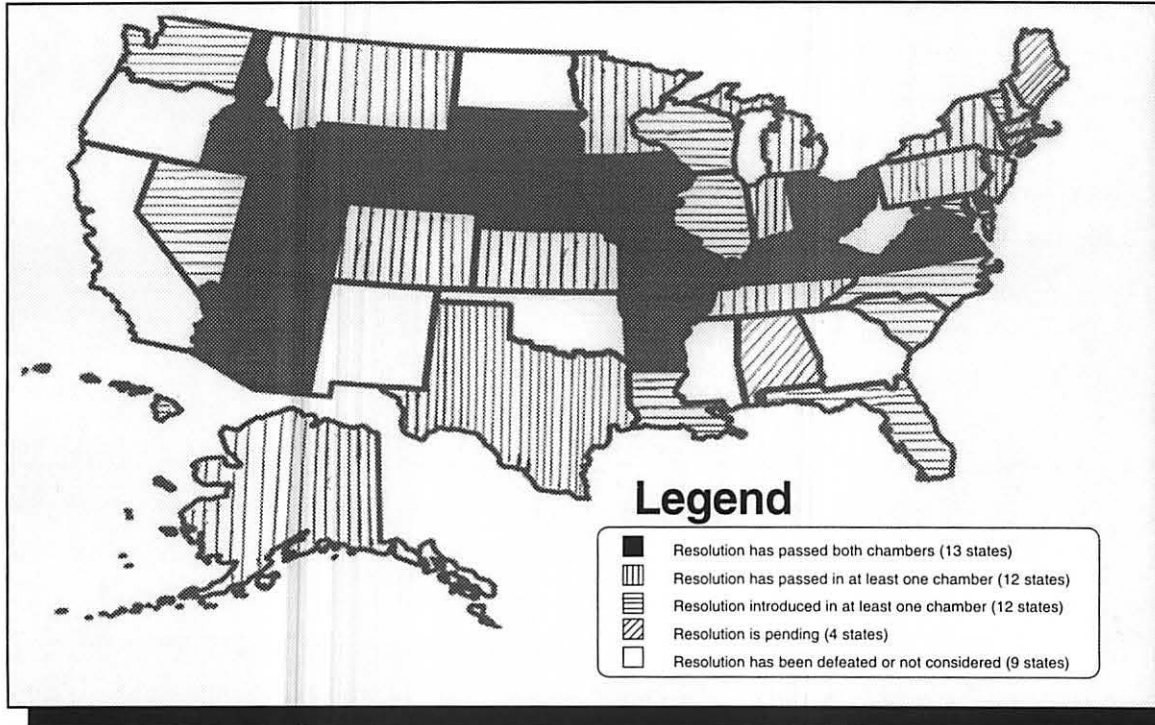
7. State Legislatures representing "We, the people," would not continue to decide on the question of whether to convene a convention once HOG's entity takes this power as COS.
8. COS plans to rewrite Article V and ratify based on the new Article V out of the convention actions empowered when COS, as House of Governors, is convened by HOG's entity.

We need go no further. A "structural" change indeed, of our U.S. constitution. The Founding Fathers knew that to make a change, which is to make an amendment, to the United States Constitution, it would have to be representative of the people, and therefore, made it a process which allows the people to have hearings in order not to rush the amending process for any reason. The Balanced Budget Amendment, or the unfunded Mandates Amendment, is a radical change to the Constitution by destroying the amending device, and placing a radically different device in the hands of a House of Governors, is more deadly than the Bomb.

Amending outside the Constitution, gives politicians the powers to undo what the Founding Fathers accomplished. However, it is not for the good of the people, or to create a great Constitution like we already possess. The Parliament of Governors (HOG) is convened by an international organization, the Council of State Governments, with cooperation of other international organizations for the purpose of destroying the Constitution for the United States of America and the transfer of power into the hands of the United Nations.

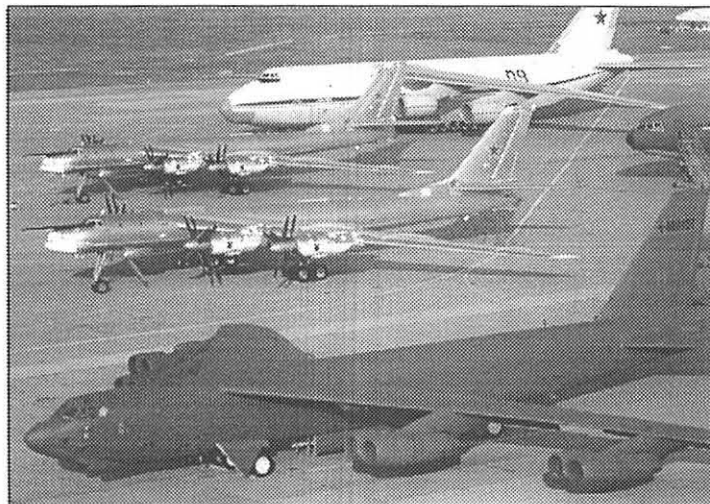

tion has jumped to 900%! Is it any wonder that we live in a fragile, manipulated economic climate?

We have allowed the bankers and the bureaucrats to steal our substance by REDEFINING OUR MONEY - Perhaps that is why John Adams once said "All of the perplexities, confusions and distresses in America arise NOT from the defects in the constitution, NOT from the want of honor or virtue, so much as the DOWNRIGHT IGNORANCE OF THE NATURE OF COIN AND CREDIT: Over 200 years ago he feared that symbolism would triumph over substance - and it appears he was right - according to the retired Federal Reserve economist, John Exter, "today's dollar is an I O U Nothing."

Imagine the absurdity of tuning into the nightly news and hearing the anchorperson say with a straight face "today in a historic move, the mile plunged by 900 feet, or the yard dropped by 8 inches," why he'd be carted off the air instantly, as we, the people would burst out in laughter, right? But that is exactly what we've been hearing all week long regarding the "plunging dollar?"

Once we can finally grasp this truth, we will have taken a quantum leap forward in debunking the modern economic mythology that has been shoved down our throats by those bent on redefining our dollar, our government, our family - our whole culture with a counterfeit dictionary. The fact is that today our redefined dollar is not a measurement of anything at all except our faith in the ability of these cultural manipulators to manage the world, and its gas pantanum debt. So in reality when they tell us that the "dollar" has fallen, what they are saying is that the faith level has fallen, and one day soon it may get up.

J.D. What are some of the consequences of NOT understanding economics?

D.B. Confusion, fear and bad decisions. Just read the headlines: "Orange County CA Cuts 10% of Employees ... Panic Pushes U.S. Currency Lower ... Fear Spreads to Stocks and Bonds ... Dollar's Fall Stokes Fears of Inflation" ...and so on.

Did you catch last week's "60 minutes"? They did an expose on the 90's high tech version of junk bonds: Derivatives. Here is a transcript, they are referred to as "legalized gambling on Wall Street, by peddling a product that even the experts cannot explain which represents a \$35 trillion Pandora's Box. Derivatives, they said, could bring the world's banking system down by vaporizing portfolios overnight - such as they already have in London with Barings Bank failure and in one

of the richest counties in America, Orange County.

John, you don't need to be a rocket scientist to see that something very fundamental is out of order - that is unless you don't possess a shared common sense or you have a financial death wish.

Economics is really very simple. It's a window into the soul, revealing our true values. The word economic is derived from two Latin words "oikos," which means household, and "nomika," which means law, or management. So economics is the study of "household management."

Even children understand this basic truth: if you agree to exchange one thing of value, (say a baseball card) you should expect to receive something else of similar value, (say a peg). It's honest, free market economics to expect value for value, substance for substance. Yet today, almost every nation on the face of the planet operates on a different set of exchange rules, which leads to CONFUSION and opens the door for symbolism to triumph over substance - which is exactly where we are today.

Economics, just like any other discipline, examines the cause and effect relationship between good management and bad management. It's the law of sowing and reaping in the material realm, if you will. If we violate these laws over the long term there will be a heavy price to pay.

Economists study these historical cause and effect economic cycles - hopefully to learn how we can improve our standard of living, increase productivity, and thus multiply wealth. But here's the problem we are facing today John:

Governments, instead of promoting honest, substance-based economics, productivity, self-government and savings always prefer to enslave the populace by promoting scarcity, debt, welfareism and symbolic money - to create a demand for more itself.

- monetary-slavery - redistributing the wealth via debt-based money systems.
- tax-slavery - taxing the people to the hilt to maintain absolute monetary control.
- ideological-slavery - creating a state managed educational and informational system.

All of which gradually leads us into a sort of totalitarian slave-state - But John, today it appears that we are still relatively happy slaves, blissfully ignorant, that is until our debt-driven life-style hits a brick wall. Modern economic bondage flies in the face of the vision of our founding fathers, our godly heritage, and, of course common sense.

The Arkansas hillbilly said it best, "it ain't so much of not knowing as it is knowing what ain't so." We must learn from history and learn to live within our means - both individually and as a nation. I believe that we still have a good foundation, or root structure to build on - the constitution and our common law heritage of hard work and honest money.

has been used several times in the past in this manner. You could say that "Strategic Investments" is an asset to the company.
