- 5) Ridden showing classes may be ridden side saddle. If a 'judge may ride' class, an astride saddle must be provided.
- 6) No smoking Hall Place is a No Smoking establishment.
- 7) Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- 8) Competitors numbers must be clearly visible.
- 9) Any rider/horse sustaining a fall in any class will be automatically retired from the class.
- 10) The Judge's decision will be final. Any objections must be made within $\frac{1}{2}$ hour of the class results with a deposit of £20. The deposit will only be returned if the objection is upheld.
- 11) All ridden horses & ponies must be 4 years & over.
- 12) Winners of Challenge Trophies will be required to sign a trophy form and return the trophy 3 weeks prior to 2024 show.
- 13) Every effort will be made to allow competitors to enter as many classes as they wish but it is the competitors responsibility to ensure they are able to get to each class. It will be the judges discretion to allow a late competitor to enter the ring. No refund can be given in the event of an earlier class over running.
