- Ken Morgan won the \$25 half-pot and the club received \$25. Ken donated his winnings back to the club for door prizes for the meetings.
- Dave and Jackie Folk will be hosting a picnic on June 6 from 12-4. Dave plans to smoke a variety of meats so bring your drink of choice along with a side dish and your appetite.
- The Tire Squeal Road Rally will be the week of June 20-28. This year you can run the course on any of these days so hopefully we get a group to go. More details will be provided at the next meeting.
- The Secretary's report was approved based on the January newsletter.
- The Treasurer's Report was given by Dave Folk.
 - 1. Last month's balance was \$5,826.38. Deposits of \$240 from dues and \$30 January half pot withdrawal of \$100 to Vision Accounting for 2018 taxes leaving a balance of \$5,994,98.
 - 2. MME 2020 Bank Account To facilitate hosting the 2020 Mini Meet East, SIR Brit will support creation of a second checking account under out Federal ID number at Old National Bank. Old National has been the SIR Brit bank since 1997, and has branches in Owensboro. The intent of this second checking account is to handle all income and expenses associated with the July 2020 Mini Meet in Owensboro. This second account will be closed by October 2020. Don Fraser and Al Frost (aka Trigger) will be authorized to manage this account.



- 3. NAMGBR memberships In order to maintain our insurance through NAMGBR we will be taking names of members who are in good standing with their SIR Brit dues for the eight memberships. To increase NAMGBR membership, new NAMGBR members will be considered first, current members who wish to have renewals will be considered next. If we get over eight names, we will have a drawing at the March meeting from the current memberships for renewal. - 4. Membership Dues Anyone who hasn't renewed their membership yet must get the form and dues in to Vince Anderson by 29 February in order to continue to receive the newsletter.
- 5. Per a discussion with the accountant; it will cost over \$1,000 each year to get an actual audit done, if we hire an independent auditor. The accountant suggested that a couple of club volunteers sit with the Treasurer and go through the books once a year. A motion was made to change the by-laws to have an internal audit annually. The motion was seconded and passed with a vote of 15-1. There will be an email vote and then volunteers will be identified.
- 6. SIR Brit 2020 Budget Submitted the draft budget for review at the meeting. The budget is included at the bottom of the newsletter.
- Mini Meet 2020 Trigger and Don Fraser reported that
 - 1. The registration form will be available this week.
 - 2. The Best Western is 2/3 full and they have lined up a second hotel for further reservations.
 - 3. They need volunteers to help during the show. If you have some time the week of July 6-10, let Don Fraser (270) 929-2620 know that you are interested. They need volunteers to hand out cards along the route of the Rally on July 8th, Thursday morning.
 - 4. A motion was made and passed unanimously for the two charities for the MME2020 to be Kentucky Honor Flight and Kentucky Veteran's Home.
 - 5. The website for the MME2020 is http://www/minimeet2020.com and it is up and running.
 - 6. They have opened a post office box for registrations.
 - Plan to join in on a run of the MME2020 rally route on May 31st. Don Fraser will provide additional details at the next meeting.
