# SIR BRIT Newsletter



#### March 9, 2020

On March 6th several members met at the Evansville Museum and a few went to lunch at Bru Burger Bar after. The day was cold and windy so we didn't see the trains, but the exhibits inside were very interesting. Those of us not from Evansville area learned how important the area was during World War II. We are planning a return visit to see the Transportation Building in the near future so stay tuned for the date and time.

#### Minutes:

- The meeting was held at Red Robin in Evansville and was opened by Dave Folk, with 18 attendees.
- Jim Havener won the \$25 halfpot and the club received \$25. Ray Graham, Donnie Oxendine and Jerry Purcell won door prizes.
- The Treasurer's Report was given by Jackie Folk.
  - 1. The current checking account balance is \$6,259.98. This is an increase of \$265 from last month, \$235 of this is dues and \$40 is for nametags ordered (but not paid for yet). Note – Dick and Carol Brown sent in \$15. Vince let them know it's actually \$20 now but gave them a "pass" this year. That's why the dues figure ends in a 5.
  - 2. Membership Update As reported before, Vince sent 20 reminder emails to 21 couples and 8 singles to pay their dues. Here's the results:
    - 7 of the couples and 3 of the singles then sent in their dues.
    - 3 couples replied that they wanted to drop their membership
    - 11 couples and 5 singles sent no reply.
    - So those 11 couples and 5 singles will be dropped from the distribution list as of March.

### **Email vote requested**

A motion was made to change the bi-laws to allow board members to run unopposed. The following change would be made to the bi-laws, if the motion passes:

"The Board of Directors will establish a Nomination Committee (three members) three months before election date for the purpose of proposing a minimum of two nominee(s) for each office to be presented to the membership."

- The Secretary's report was approved based on the February newsletter.
- Bi-law change to Annual Audit a vote was taken to change the bi-laws to read "The Treasurer will ensure that an internal financial Annual Audit is conducted no later than April 1 of the previous year's income vs. expenses compared to the bank balance ending March 31. The audit team shall be comprised of current club members selected by the Board. The purpose of this audit is to determine if any financial irregularities have occurred and will be reported in writing to the Board." The vote was unanimous both at the meeting and with the email votes.
- Bi-law change to Nomination Procedures A motion was made to change the bi-laws from requiring two people for each board position on the ballot to allowing an unopposed nominee. If approved, the wording will be "The Board of Directors will establish a Nomination Committee (three members) three months before election date for the purpose of proposing nominee(s) for each office to be presented to the membership. The board itself may elect to perform this task. The vote will be taken at the April meeting along with the email votes received between now and the meeting. Don will be heading up a trial road rally on May 31<sup>st</sup> in preparation of the MME2020. Further details will be available at the April meeting. Moonlite BBQ is interested in having the club host a cruise-in on May 30<sup>th</sup> from 11-3.
- Mini Meet 2020 Dave Folk and Don Fraser reported that MME2020 has invited SIR Brit to have a cruise-in on Wednesday during the show. Future details will be provided at the next meeting. The Monday before the meet anyone interested can go to Bowling Green to the Corvette Museum and for \$75 drive around the track behind a corvette.
- <u>Charity for car show</u> Holly's House was voted on as the charity for the car show. "Holly's House is a non-residential child and adult advocacy center for victims of intimate crimes. It's a safe location where adult and child victims of intimate violence are interviewed and connected to community resources and services as needed.
