Minutes:

- The meeting was held at Logan's Roadhouse in Evansville and was opened by Clay Robinson, with 16 attendees.
- Jackie Folk won the half-pot of \$28.00.
- Door prizes were won by Jim Havener, Ray Hanes, Jerry Purcell, and Al Saloff.
- We had a couple of new members attend the meeting. Welcome Bob Wompler; owner of a 1973 TR6 and Jim McKinney; owner of a 1963 Sprite and a 1966 3000.
- The Secretary's report was approved based on the September newsletter.
- The Treasurer's Report was given by Clay Robinson. Last month's balance was \$5,6,28.34. With a deposit of \$166.23, leaving a balance of \$5,794.57. The \$500 donation to the Kidney Foundation was made. With only the shuttle bus invoice outstanding from the car show we are showing a positive balance. The report of actuals to budget will be available at the November meeting.
- Discussion on making the Treasurer and Secretary positions open-ended was held. A motion was made to allow the Treasurer and Secretary to maintain the position for longer than the current two-year period. The stipulation was included that there be an annual vote and a yearly outside-party audit of the books. The motion was seconded and with a vote of 13 to 0 from the attending

- 2019 S.I.R. Brit Car Show – Clay Robinson reported that everything went well at the show. The following items were discussed for future shows.
 1. A first aid kit available as well as a few stations set up with shade and chairs for people to get out of the heat. It was suggested that members may have awnings and chairs to be used for the day and we need to ensure that any awnings on the field are tied down securely. Keep in mind that someone would be needed to man each of these stations. It would be a good idea to alert the nearby Fire Station that we are having a show on that day prior to future shows.
 2. Entering the field on the right of the registration desk is a concern with the drop-off at that corner. The suggestion was made that we look into entering on the far side of that field at future shows.
