
Minutes

- <u>The Treasurer's Report</u> was given by Vince Anderson. The August balance was \$6,065.08 with a deposit of \$17 the balance is now \$6,082.08.
- The Secretary Report The minutes were approved based on the August Newsletter.
- Cruise-In Update Discussion was held on
 - 1. Having registration and 3 trophies Sara Karr volunteered to register cars and hand out a 3x5 car for each car owner to place their number in their car.
