#### E-PAYMENTS ARE HERE – DUES

COVID-19 has impacted the club with mailing delays for the dues notices. Additionally, members have requested an electronic system for dues payment. Recently, NHRC parent membership voted to adopt an electronic payment process. The following letter was addressed to membership with the dues notices noting the advancement to E-payments. If you have not sent in your dues remittance for 2022, the letter below provides instructions for sending in payment.

"The issues with postal delays last year were just part of our changing world as the Covid-19 pandemic continues to alter how we live our lives and conduct business.

One of the things we've wanted to do was to provide an electronic means of paying our annual dues. We are happy to say that beginning this year, members will be able to use Venmo to pay their dues. For those that already have Venmo accounts, you know the process is easy and notification of payment is immediate; no more wondering if the Club has received your check or if the check has been deposited. Venmo is a free service and requires no convenience fees. For those that may not have a Venmo account, the process to create one is easy and secure. (Continued on next page – E-Payments)

**Indoor Hours** 

Mon.-Sat. 8 AM to **10 PM** Sunday 1 PM to **10 PM** 

Outdoor and DPR Hours

Mon.-Sat. 8 AM to sundown Sunday 1 PM to sundown

**Membership Cards**. All members are <u>required</u> to display their membership card and sign in while using the range facilities.

**Non-members**. Non-members may only use the club facilities under the following conditions:

- 1) they are with a current NHRC club member and
- 2) they have completed a Liability form. Liability forms are located in the club house and on the outdoor range. Place completed (signed and dated) forms back in the bin. A form must be completed yearly.

**Targets.** Only paper targets and various steel targets provided by NHRC are approved for use. All other non-approved targets are not permitted and in violation of club rules.

**Trap Shoots.** Trap shoots are held on Tuesday evenings starting at 5:00 PM from April to October. The shoots are open to the public.

# HAVING A LITTLE FUN WITHOUT AMMO

As I sat here wondering what I could share for the newsletter, I happened to be thinking about those of us who have seen guns and passed on a great purchase or deal because I didn't really like the finish, or the grips, or any of the other options on them.

Have you ever thought about maybe having a gun cerakoted or duracoated? These ceramic and polymer finished not only offer protection but come in over 300 colors. It's not really that difficult to have done, nor is it that expensive. How about changing the grip panels to something different? You can even change the controls, the slide release, or the safety on a firearm.

Start by making the firearm unique to you and different than the run of the mill gun that you will find at your local gun store. You will find a lot of these options are easy to have done with no effect on the internal mechanisms of the firearm.

Here is an example of a gun I have personalized. It is a Glock 43 X that when I purchased it, it had the black frame and the unfinished looking silver slide. I hated the way it looked but loved the feel of the gun. I had the slide repainted in midnight bronze and added tritium fiber optic sights. Then on the frame, I bought a set of traction grips off eBay and covered the grip area and underneath the trigger guard. A friend of mine liked it so much that he had his done to match mine - that to me is a great compliment.

On my revolvers I enjoy changing the grips. Very rarely do I keep the standard ones that come on the firearm. There are so many beautiful styles and designs that can make the gun more aesthetically pleasing. This

easy and simple change can give the gun more personalization. New grips can also make the firearm even easier to shoot. I often change the grips just for something different. It is not as costly as buying a different gun and just as satisfying. I do that to my 1911's also, change the grips panels or change the slide release or thumb safety

Everybody should have one gun that is a flashy, what they call a "Texas BBQ or Sunday gun." It's the gun you wear when you get dressed up and has a unique look to it; combine that with fancy holster and it's a sight for everybody to see and admire.




So yes, your gun is for self-defense but have a little imagination and make it one that will be admired.
