<u>Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes and Financial Report</u> – Ryan Strohecker entertained a motion to approve the previous meeting minutes and financial report from October 11, 2023. Kent Gardner so motioned, Barry Hershey seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Old Business

a. The UCC agreement has been updated. All participating municipalities have received the signed copy for their records.

New Business

- a. Senator Scott Martin Legislative Update. Deputy Chief of Staff Terry Trego updated the group on recent and current legislation. A few highlights:
 - The Senate is still working on the final budget items which lagged behind from the last budget adoption.
 - Senator Martin is aware of that Right-to-Know continues to create issues for many of our municipalities, mostly due to out-of-town businesses.
 - With the current makeup of the legislature, bills are taking a long time to move.
 - Radar remains a hot topic. Legislation gets closer to adoption each year, but hasn't quite made it yet.
- b. Nominating Committee.
 - Motion by Mark Stivers, seconded by Kent Gardner, to elect Ryan Strohecker Chair, Barry Hershey – Vice Chair, Rick Kane – Treasurer, Andrew Stern – Secretary. Motion carried unanimously.
- c. Audit Committee.
 - Audit committee member Andrew Stern indicated that the audit determined all was in good order with our finances.
- d. Budget.
 - Chair Ryan Strohecker commented that we are doing well fiscally and are recommending a dues reduction in the 2024 budget. Motion by Lauren Hauck, seconded by Kent Gardner to adopt the 2024 budget. Motion carried unanimously.
- e. Adjacent Municipalities.
 - Chairman Ryan Strohecker explained that a municipality expressed interest in joining LIMC but is not adjacent to a current member, as required by the LIMC agreement. After brief discussion, it was decided to discuss this at a future meeting.

County Commissioners' Update

- The 2024 budget should pass next week.
- The jail project is moving forward.
- The swimming pool will be ready to open on time for 2024.
- The MPO had four applicants for their Smart Growth program:
 - City of Lancaster
 - East Hempfield Township
 - o Manheim Township
 - Mount Joy Borough
- The Bike Share program has been approved to go outside of the City to East Lampeter Township and Manheim Township.
- The County is still reviewing requests for ARPA funds for infrastructure. LCPD helped rank the projects. Deliberation will occur soon.
- The County adopted a volunteer fire firefighter credit of \$150 towards County real estate taxes. Will be a rebate check from the County. Volunteers can go to the County's website to download an application.

Municipal Exchange

Columbia Borough:

- Looking into what to do with large street trees. If any other municipality has ideas, please let Mark know.
- Looking into what to do with for-profit events, related to fees. Please let Mark know if you have ideas.
- Mark attended a meeting about outdoor recreation and how it has helped with promoting economic development.

Mountville Borough:

- Their auditor decided not to do municipal audits anymore. They were able to contract with White Rudy for their 2023 audit. Bertz and Hess was also interested.
- Council voted to close Spring Street at the rail crossing. Now waiting for the PUC to approve.
- A new traffic signal has been installed and Main and Manor. It has red, yellow, and green lights.

West Hempfield Township:

• We have been advised that we may have to collect 'alternative fuel taxes' for persons using our electric vehicle chargers. We are awaiting further clarity from the Department of Revenue.

• Working to promote rain gardens. Municipalities should make sure we aren't prohibiting recommended plants as "weeds".

Lancaster County Planning:

• LCPD is planning Spring regional planning meetings.

Manheim Township:

- This is Barry Kauffman's last meeting. The Township thanked him for his contributions.
- They have a new Police Chief Duane Fisher.
- They have a new Finance Director.

Millersville Borough:

- New Manager Rebecca DeSantis-Randall.
- No new taxes for 2024.
- The last large tract in the Borough has been purchased.

Pequa Township:

- This is E. John Hlavacek's last meeting.
- The New Danville Mennonite School is starting a \$9 million upgrade.

LASA:

• Completed their union collective bargaining agreement.

City of Lancaster:

• Approved a new Comprehensive Plan.

East Petersburg Borough:

• Looking for a new auditor as theirs no longer does municipal work.

East Lampeter Township:

- The USGA golf tournament is return.
- Route 30 streetscape project is starting.
- Housing plan finishing in 2024.
- Comprehensive Plan starting in 2024.

West Lampeter Township:

- DeeDee retired and Rebecca Denlinger is their new Manager.
- They have a new Public Works Director.
- Looking into salt brine systems.
- Looking to hire a new Community Development Director.
- Starting a document management system project.
- Will be amending their zoning ordinance.
- Will be developing a Capital Improvement Plan.

East Hempfield Township:

- Centerville Road project is going well.
- Old Rohrerstown Road bridge project continues to drag trying to resolve utility issues.
