GUIDELINES FOR WAQG COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

- The opportunity to apply for a scholarship will include:
 - Direct relatives (child, grandchild, spouse, or parent) of current WAQG members who have been active for at least 6 months.
 - Because the elected officers (President, Vice President, Asst. Vice President, Treasurer and Asst. Treasurer) of the Board of the Woodlands Area Quilt Guild are key decision makers, their family members may not apply for the scholarship during their term in office.
 - No current members of WAQG shall be eligible for a scholarship.

All applicants:

- Must be from students who have been approved for an accredited program at the post high school level. Degree programs as well as certification programs will be accepted.
- Must provide a current official transcript. This must come directly to the Scholarship Committee Chair from the student's registrar in a sealed envelope or via email.
- Must provide proof of enrollment in an accredited program or a letter of acceptance from an institution of higher learning.
- Must provide the required documentation prior to scholarship funds being awarded.
- Students who are awarded a scholarship and who continue in their field of study may apply for a second scholarship the following year. A current official transcript and proof of continued enrollment must be provided with the application.
- Students who are awarded a scholarship and who continue in their field of study in a four-year degree program may apply for three additional scholarships. A current official transcript and proof of continued enrollment must be provided with the application.
