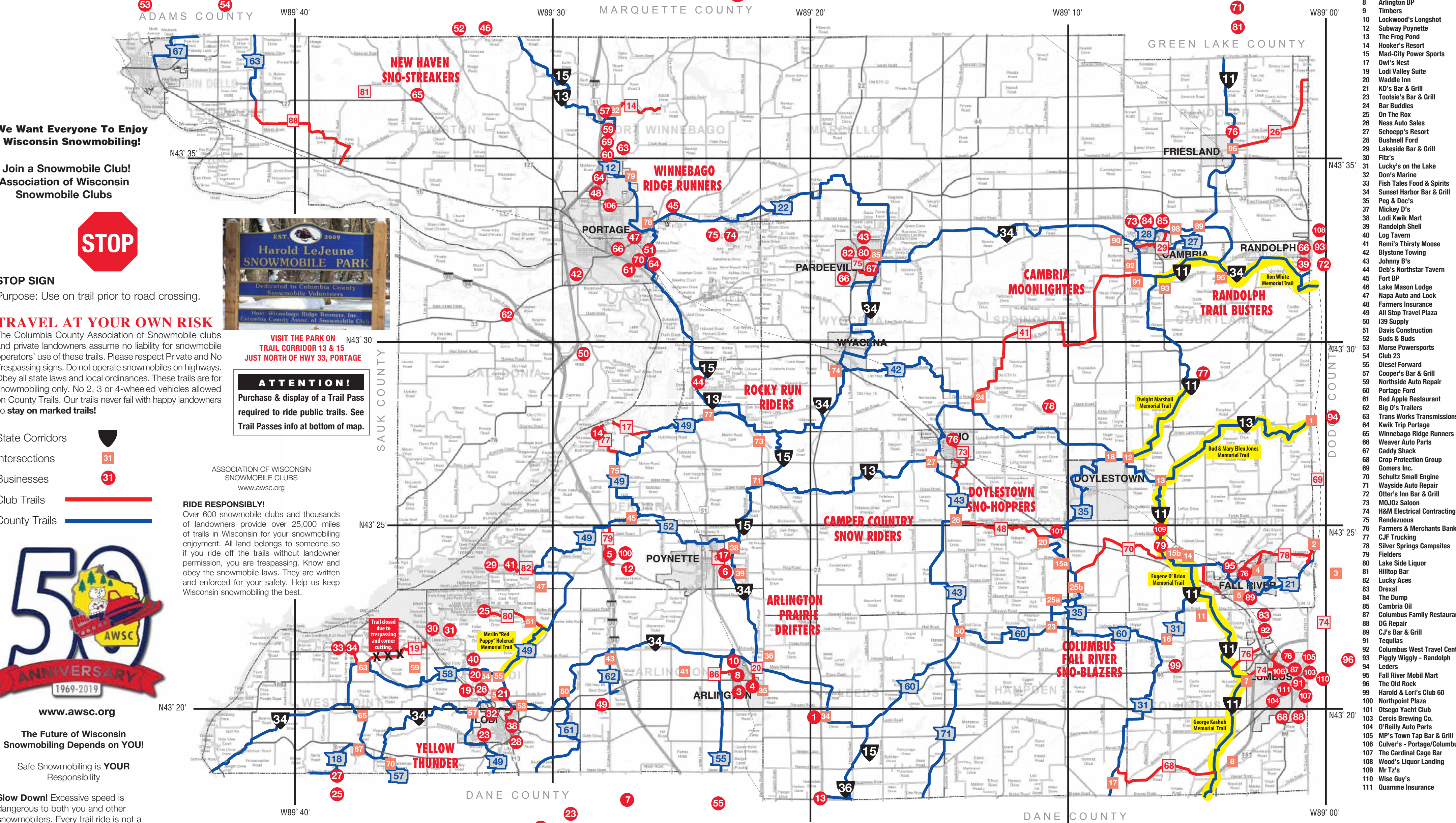

Safe Snowmobiling is **YOUR** Responsibility

Slow Down! Excessive speed is dangerous to both you and other snowmobilers. Every trail ride is not a cross-country race.
Ride Sober! Alcohol or drugs affect your riding ability. Save the party for after the ride.
Stay on Trails! The trails are established for safe riding. Many trails are on private property and will be closed if there are problems.

PLEASE BE A RESPONSIBLE SNOWMOBILER

All snowmobile trails are for snowmobile use ONLY and ATV & UTV's are not allowed on them.

All trails are subject to change pending landowner permission. Safety course required if born after 1/1/1985.

TRAIL PASSES

Effective July 1, 2015, all snowmobiles operating on a Wisconsin snowmobile trail or corridor must display a valid snowmobile trail pass whether registered in Wisconsin or another state in addition to having the snowmobile registered. Trail passes expire on the following June 30th. For snowmobiles registered in Wisconsin and owned by a person who is both a member of a snowmobile club and a member of AWSC, passes may be ordered through the AWSC website (www.awsc.org) or the DeForest office at a cost of \$10 each. Trail passes are delivered by US Mail. For snowmobiles registered in Wisconsin, passes are available online at dnr.wi.gov or at any DNR license sales agent at a cost of \$30 each. For snowmobiles registered in or in the process of being registered in another state, province or country, non-resident trail passes are available online at dnr.wi.gov or at any DNR select agent at a cost of \$50 each. All Wisconsin snowmobile trail passes will be shipped by US Mail. A temporary operating receipt is issued when orders are placed at dnr.wi.gov and at DNR license sales locations to operate legally on snowmobile trails. Carry the receipt with you until your pass is delivered by the US Mail and affixed to your snowmobile's windshield.

GPS INFORMATION

Although nearly all of the trail intersections in Columbia County are well marked, snowmobilers who are familiar with or may be using GPS (Global Positioning System) units will note that new trail maps show latitude and longitude coordinates along the margins that may be helpful in pinpointing your location.
