

With the generosity of our Supporters and AWC members, our extensive fundraising activities, and the priceless time and talents volunteered by our over 150 AWC members and their spouses, we were able to enrich Arley and the surrounding community by **\$143,000** in 2023.

- Partnered with Walker Area Community Foundation, and the Arley Senior Center to complete Phase I renovations to open the beautiful new Arley/Smith Lake Senior Outreach Center on Hwy 41 in Arley.
- \$19,000 in scholarships were awarded to graduating seniors at Meek High
 School, including our endowed scholarship at Wallace State Community College.
- Funds were awarded to our local schools during the Fall and Spring Charitable Giving Cycles for:

- Continued our Arley Recycling Program, in its 6th year
- After introducing the popular sport of **Pickleball** to Arley in 2022, we provided wind screens and benches for the 2 new pickleball courts in Hamner Park
- Provided funding for equipment for the Arley and Helicon Volunteer Fire

- Provided funding for revitalizing Winston County's famous music, arts and entertainment venue, **Looney's Tavern**
