Range Closures: Club members are reminded that the Griswold ranges are closed all day on Saturday until the end of pheasant hunting season.

Range Safety: Members are reminded that while people are down-range, anywhere in front of the firing line, ensure all firearms are unloaded, with actions open, pointing down range or cased. No handling of firearms while people are down range. Members entertaining guests at the ranges; while they are shooting, you are observing them, and while you are shooting your guests should be observing you. You are responsible for your guests.

Griswold Archery Range Target Stands: The archery range has been setup at the Griswold property. The yardages are as follows: 20, 30, 40, 50, 60 and 70. All disciplines of archery can be used on Morrell bag targets, crossbow, compound, recurve and longbow. Field points can only be used on these targets. These targets are **NOT** intended for broadhead arrows, broadhead's will cut the targets to pieces and most likely not stop the crossbow bolt.

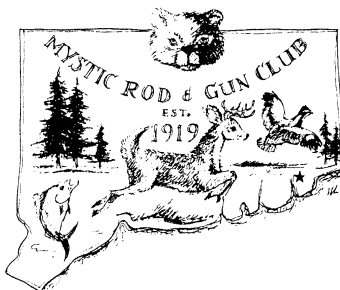
Firearms Safety and Marksmanship Workshop: Because basic marksmanship and firearms safety are things that even experienced shooters can always improve on... Topics will include basic firearms safety, and pistol marksmanship skills to include, grip, stance, shooting positions, breathing, trigger control, proper sight alignment, and follow through. There will be both dry fire and live fire portions in the workshop. All participants must bring eye and hearing protection. This workshop will be on February 10th at 9:00 am at the Stonington indoor range, seats are limited to the first 16 members or family, the cost will be \$20 per shooter and lunch will be provided.
