Range Safety: Members are reminded that while people are down-range, anywhere in front of the firing line, ensure all firearms are unloaded, with actions open, pointing down range or cased. No handling of firearms while people are down range. Members entertaining guests at the ranges; while they are shooting, you are observing them, and while you are shooting your guests should be observing you. You are responsible for your guests.

Griswold Archery Range Target Stands: The archery range has been setup at the Griswold property. The vardages are as follows: 20, 30, 40, 50, 60 and 70. All disciplines of archery can be used on Morrell bag targets, crossbow, compound, recurve and longbow. Field points can only be used on these targets. These targets are NOT intended for broadhead arrows, broadhead's will cut the targets to pieces and most likely not stop the crossbow bolt.
