Archery Range Target Stands: The yardages are as follows: 20, 30, 40, 50, 60 and 70. All disciplines of archery can be used on Morrell bag targets, crossbow, compound, recurve and longbow. Field points can only be used on these targets. These targets are **NOT** intended for broadhead arrows, broadhead's will cut the targets to pieces and most likely not stop the crossbow bolt.

Hunting Stands: All tree stands need to be removed from the Griswold property... We are already past the April 1st deadline according to posted rules. Ensure you are shooting only paper targets on the rifle range. NO exploding targets, bottles, cans, or targets that leave trash on the range. No armor piercing or tracer ammo.
