## Griswold Range & Clubhouse News:

**Archery Range Target Stands:** The yardages are as follows: 20, 30, 40, 50, 60 and 70. All disciplines of archery can be used on Morrell bag targets, crossbow, compound, recurve and longbow. Field points can only be used on these targets. These targets are **NOT** intended for broadhead arrows, broadhead's will cut the targets to pieces and most likely not stop the crossbow bolt.

**Hunting Stands:** All tree stands need to be removed from the Griswold property... We are already past the April 1<sup>st</sup> deadline according to posted rules. Stands may be re-hung starting August 1<sup>st</sup> in anticipation of the 2018 season. If there are any issues, please call Chris McVeigh (game chairman) at (401) 749-0922.

**Rifle/Pistol Range Target Stands:** If anyone needs to repair the portable target stand at the 25-yard line, there are repair pieces in the sheds. If the target stands at 50 & 100 yds require repair and you can do it please do. Any minimal expenses will be reimbursed at the club meeting. Anything over \$25 contact a member of the BOD. **Clubhouse Remodel:** Griswold clubhouse remodeling has begun. The clubhouse has been gutted to the bare studs so if you need work hours, especially if you're a tradesman, contact Eric Sabo to see where you can fit in on the construction schedule. Hot and cold water is available at the outside faucets.

**Fishing:** As of June 1st you can keep a limit of trout when fishing the pond.

## Stonington Clubhouse News:

**Property Maintenance:** The Stonington Property can always use mowing, trimming and picking up of downed branches. Tractor and trimmer are in the shed along with fuel.

**A/C System:** Our 40 plus year old AC system at the Stonington clubhouse has finally given out. Installing a new system is on hold until after the Griswold remodel is finished up.

**Range Safety:** Members are reminded that while people are down-range, anywhere in front of the firing line, ensure all firearms are unloaded, with actions open, pointing down range or cased. No handling of firearms while people are down range. Members entertaining guests at the ranges; while they are shooting, you are observing them, and while you are shooting your guests should be observing you. You are responsible for your guests. And... Ensure you are shooting only paper targets on the rifle range. NO exploding targets, bottles, cans, or targets that leave trash on the range. No armor piercing or tracer ammo. If you see something not appropriate for our range say something or contact the board or directors.
