Hunting Season Approaches: Club members will be permitted to hang tree stands on Griswold property starting August 15. Those that do, please make sure that you label & log your tree stands in the appropriate hunting Logbook.

Griswold Range & Clubhouse News:

Archery Range Target Stands: The yardages are as follows: 20, 30, 40, 50, 60 and 70. All disciplines of archery can be used on Morrell bag targets, crossbow, compound, recurve and longbow. Field points can only be used on these targets. These targets are **NOT** intended for broadhead arrows, broadhead's will cut the targets to pieces and most likely not stop the crossbow bolt.

Rifle/Pistol Range Target Stands: If anyone needs to repair the portable target stand at the 25-yard line, there are repair pieces in the sheds. If the target stands at 50 & 100 yds require repair and you can do it please do. Any minimal expenses will be reimbursed at the club meeting. Anything over \$25 contact a member of the BOD. Contact Tim Hausler if you need to log work hours doing range maintenance.

Clubhouse Remodel: Griswold clubhouse remodeling has begun. The clubhouse has been gutted to the bare studs so if you need work hours, especially if you're a tradesman, contact Eric Sabo to see where you can fit in on the construction schedule.
