Tuning Your Ukulele Your playing will never sound good if your ukulele isn't in tune.

The easiest way to tune your ukulele is with an electronic tuner, but it's important that you understand how to use your tuner. Some tuners have various settings for different instruments and different pitch settings – but these can lead to tuning mistakes if you accidentally select the wrong setting. If your tuner has an instrument setting (usually indicated by letters such as B, G, U etc.) we recommend selecting the letter C. This stands for the word chromatic. If there is a pitch setting you need this to be on 440.

If in doubt about your tuner consider investing in one that is simple to use and has a large clear display, such as a Snark tuner.

A standard 4 string soprano, concert or tenor ukulele is tuned to the notes G, C, E, A

The string at the top (nearest to the ceiling) is tuned to a G, then working down the instrument the next string is tuned to C, then E and then the string closest to the floor is tuned to an A. The strings are connected to the tuning mechanism in the following arrangement;



Tightening the string will raise the pitch of the note, when you slacken the string the note will go lower. Look at your ukulele sideways on (directly at the tuning mechanism) Turning the mechanism clockwise will lower the pitch, turning anticlockwise will raise the pitch. The pictures below show how to raise the pitch.





If your tuner is not showing the correct letter name for the string you are tuning, you need to think through the alphabet to work out whether to make the note higher or lower – remember that in music A follows G, for example;



Sharps and flats are the notes in between these letters. Sharp (♯) means the note is a little bit higher (so F♯ is a bit higher than normal F). Flat (♭) means the note is a little bit lower (so B♭ is a little bit lower than normal B). Lastly – Remember to tune regularly – Even the best Ukes go out of tune

Right Hand Fingering and the Common Strokes


The "Common" or "Ordinary" stroke is the basis of all the other right hand strokes and should be thoroughly mastered before any of the more complicated strokes are attempted.

Strumming

A basic common strumming stroke is made up of a downstroke followed by an upstroke


Downstroke

Starting 1-2 inches above the neck of the instrument, lightly strike the strings with the nail of the first finger and follow through until 1-2 inches away on the opposite side. The movement should be with the wrist and the forearm, not the full arm.



Upstroke

Brush the strings with the soft, fleshy part of the first finger returning to the starting position for the next downstroke.



The thumb or a light plectrum can also be used.

Left Hand Fingers and Chord Diagrams

The standard ukulele chord diagram is simply a vertical representation of the ukulele fret board.

The horizontal lines represent the frets.


The vertical lines represent the strings. The numbers on the vertical lines represent the fingers of the left hand (index=1, middle=2, ring=3 and pinky=4).

A little "o" above a vertical line indicates that the open string (a string with no left hand finger on it) below that "o" should be strummed.

A little "x", which you probably will rarely see, would mean that you do not strum that open string.


Here is a picture of the finger position for a C chord, and a chord diagram of the same chord:





Because there are three little "o"s above the three strings that have no fingers on them, they are to be strummed as well.
