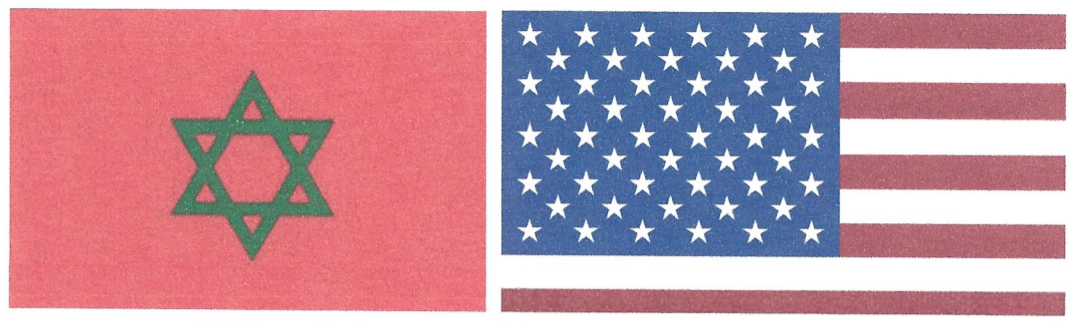

On November 12, 2020 in a humble swearing in ceremony, during the 2020 corona virus pandemic, Hashim Ali Jabar OdoKhan- El (Born Quinn Ryan Foster) was sworn in as Chief Justice and Magistrate of the Washitaw County AFAM Ecclesiastical Court. There were two witnesses present, including: Irvin P. Foster (Hashim’s father), who resides in Maryland Republic, North America, as well as Anthony Gaston Bey of Ohio

**Chief Justice/Magistrate Quinn Ryan Foster (CJ):**
