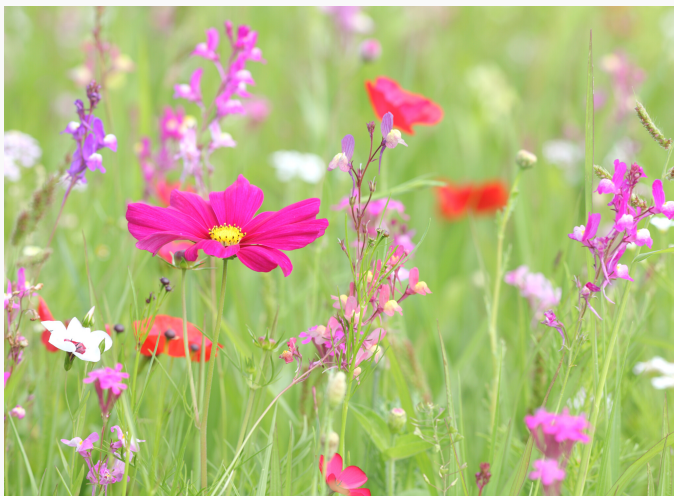

- For in person students, performances will be recorded in the studio, the week of June 13-18
- Online students, please send your videos by June 13 if possible
- Dress code -summery, to match our Summer Moods theme (a little more formal than for the composition Show -Off)

- Beginners can get a head start in learning some of the basics of piano playing

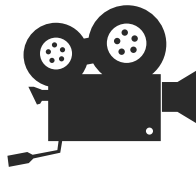
