

Immediate Complete Denture(s) Timeline

Immediate Dentures:
Appointment 1: removal of back teeth <i>8 weeks to allow healing</i>
Appointment 2: Impressions <i>1 ½ weeks in lab</i>
Appointment 3: Wax Rims (no teeth only wax) <i>1 ½ weeks in lab</i>
Appointment 4: Wax Try-in (with teeth) <i>1 ½ weeks in lab</i>
Appointment 5: Extraction of front teeth And delivery of dentures
Total time: approximately 12-13 weeks
With immediate dentures the denture is placed in your mouth immediately after extraction of the front teeth. Your gum tissue will heal underneath. Since your gum tissue will change shape after the extractions the denture will need to be relined after 3 months. The reline is included in the cost of the immediate dentures

Appointment 1: impressions <i>1 ½ weeks in lab</i>
Appointment 2: wax rims (no teeth only wax) <i>1 ½ weeks in lab</i>
Appointment 3: wax try-in (with teeth) <i>1 ½ weeks in lab</i>
Appointment 4: delivery of dentures
Total time: <i>approximately 5-6 weeks</i>
