SPECIAL JUNIOR - HOLBAM CELTIC WIZARD

1st Bamsey's HOLBAM CELTIC WIZARD – A dog I first judged when a raw puppy, I believed I could see lots of promise and today I could see how he has developed into a lovely male of correct balance, strong jaw well furnished, dark small expressive eyes under good brow, small well set and used ears giving that expression. Strong moderate length of neck nice fringe, straight laid-back shoulders level backline to well set and carried tail over a body with length with

enough depth and ribs well back to a short loin. Good front and rear with muscle tome, nicely boned and crisply furnished legs with tight small round feet and clean pads. Shown in a rich red harsh wiry jacket having correct presentation. Positive mover covers the ground well, good front action. Rear movement a fraction close but with good drive.

2nd Ruffles & Williamson's **HOLBAM CELTIC ERIN** – Little to separate these two very nice bitches who today were beaten by their litter brother. Loved her overall size and balance and although I would have liked a little more length to her foreface feel she had the correct flat skull and enough total length with nice furnishing, small eyes, with shape and colouring. Moderate neck of strength into laid shoulders, firm level backline to high set

tail of nice length and carriage. Lovely chest and body with length and depth, ribs well back, very well presented and textured rich red coat. Straight forelegs well boned and coated, moved out with good action, slightly closer behind than her brother and slightly better action than the 3<sup>rd</sup> her sister.

1st Simons' **SAREDON RED BERRY** – Another boy I have had the opportunity to judge before, I did not recognise him straight away as he has developed and matured and showed good ring presence on the stance and his movement was so sound with good forward reach and sound rear drive. Well balanced head, good skull and balanced foreface with strong jaw nicely furnished. Bright dark eyes under good brows, neat well set ears. Muscular neck into well laid-back

shoulders, firm back line to high set and carried tail. Best of angled front with good depth. Body with substance and depth with ribs well back to short loin. Straight well boned forelegs, moderate return of stifle well-muscled, short hocks correctly presented rich wiry red wheaten jacked of good texture, well-furnished legs, tight clean pads to feet. Very sound boy with good action.

Cooke's **MONTELLE LOOK OF GOLD** – Loved the look of this boys outline on the stance, of nice size and balance. Masculine balanced head, flat skull, well set and used ears, eyes dark but a little too round. Correct neck to shoulders well laid back into a firm level back line to high set well carried tail. Muscular hindquarters with moderate return of stifle and short hocks. Enough depth to chest, body well ribbed back. Very well presented harsh textured red jacket. Crisply furnished legs and clean pads to feet. Today had a slight problem with his

movement, slightly close behind and toeing out had good reach and drive.

### 3rd Atkin's GENGIS KHAN SPECIAL OPEN BITCH (4)

1st Atkin's HOLBAM CELTIC **SUMMER ShCM ShCEX** – I really like this stylish and very feminine bitch, I do appreciate she is slightly taller than some bitches but she is so well balanced and put together and has a lovely racy outline and so sound on the move with good reach Very feminine, well and drive. presented, furnished and balanced developed length to her head, flat skull, dark bright eyes under good brows, neat folded and correctly placed ears. Strong jaw, clean

throat muscular fringed neck, laid back long shoulders, straight front with depth to chest, straight boned forelegs nicely furnished and presented, tight round feet, clean pads. Strong well-turned stifle with straight hocks. Nice length to body with substance so well ribbed back with stylish well-presented rich red wiry jacker.

Nolcini's **HOLBAM CELTIC KATE ShCM** – Another bitch I really like and think she is so representative of the breed on the stance and with good shape and her balanced outline, today she did not look to be in good coat condition. Very feminine slightly chiselled head with flat skull and good length, small dark eyes under good brows. Neat small ears well set apart and used well, head well furnished. Proud head carriage on good clean neck of fair length with some fringe. Shoulders well laid back into a top line today looked a little dipped as front legs were being placed slightly too forward. Well set and carried tail. Nicely angulated front and rear, correctly bodied with depth, ribs well back into short loin. Muscular hindquarter, good return of stifle and short hocks. Moved out well and soundly not the stylish action I have seen before. I understand that she had been ill over the past weeks.
