If we ask you to provide any information you can be assured that it will only be used in accordance with this privacy policy. The type of information that we might collect from you are:

- Name

- Telephone number
- Email address
- Any relevant information about you and your horse

We only collect this information for business-related purposes in order to:

- To provide you with a follow up service and as an on-going record of your horse's saddle fitting needs
- To be able to recognise any changes in your horse between saddle fittings
- Internal record keeping
- Internal research and development

We will only share your personal data with third parties on occasions where it is deemed necessary to do so to provide you with our full service – we will advise you of this at the time.

Devon Saddle Fitters are committed to ensuring your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable measures to safeguard and secure the information. This includes:

- Protecting against accidental loss
- Prevent unauthorised access, use, destruction or disclosure
- To restrict access to personal information
- To manage third party risks, through the use of contracts and security reviews.

Devon Saddle Fitters only hold customer personal data for a period of three years unless we provide you with a follow up service. Any personal data is securely disposed of after the 3 years have lapsed.
