



PLEASE NOTE AFTER INSTALLATION

A slight milky haze under the film or areas of small, flat bubbles are a normal part of the curing process and will disappear. Leave these areas alone and **DO NOT** attempt to push or press them out.

After 24 hours, run your finger along all of the edges of the film, gently pressing any loose edges back into place. Wait 48 hours after installation to wash your car.



To keep your film looking great, follow a few simple guidelines:

- After about 7 days, the film should be completely cured. Please let us know if you notice any air bubbles. We can take care of those by carefully poking a tiny hole and pushing the air out.
- Remove insect or other stains as soon as possible with XPEL Film Cleaner.
- Stubborn stains can be removed with 99% isopropyl alcohol. Take care to keep these chemicals off the vehicle's paint.
- Seal with XPEL Flawless Finish Paint Protection Film Sealant at least once every 3 months to preserve high gloss or for long term protection, consider having the film and the vehicle finish protected with the ceramic coating (more information at blockachip.com).
- Light scratches in the film will self-heal in 20-30 minutes at room temperature. In colder conditions, or to accelerate the process, pour warm water (120°F) over the affected area.
- Avoid using a pressure washer or high-pressure water source near the edges of the film, it can cause the film to lift and/or become damaged
- Detailing Clay can be used to remove contaminants that are on the film.



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
