



ALL CHURCH MEETING MINUTES

251st **Annual Meeting Minutes** Southwick Congregational Church United Church of Christ February 4, 2024

The meeting was called to order by Moderator Terry Putnam at 12:20 p.m. and was held in Old Fellowship Hall following our 11 a.m. morning worship service and a delicious lasagna luncheon. An opening prayer was led by our Pastor, Rev. Paul B. Nesbit. The Moderator then asked for a moment to recognize and remember Beverly Lindsey who passed away in 2023. Beverly recently became a member of our church posthumously when her husband Donald joined our congregation.

The Moderator asked for a motion from the floor, which was seconded and passed unanimously, to dispense with the reading of the Call to the Annual Meeting.

A count was taken around the room with 25 voting members present – a quorum of 15 was achieved.

The Moderator entertained a motion from the floor to accept the Clerk's Report/Minutes of last year's 250th Annual Meeting which was seconded, and with no discussion, was passed unanimously.

Pastor:

Rev. Paul Nesbit hoped that everyone had a chance to read the Annual Report. He was pleased to report this is the beginning of his third year at Southwick Congregational Church. His goal is to keep the doors to this church wide open and invite people in. He reports we are doing great as a church community and hopes everyone comes not only for the sermon but because they feel welcome and included. His personal goal as our pastor is to get out and see more people in the community. He has asked everyone to email him directly with questions or concerns, to please

communicate with him, and he will do what he can as soon as possible.

Moderator:

Terry Putnam agreed it has been a very good two years with Rev. Paul as our pastor. She offered a heartfelt thank you to Virgil Paggen for his many years of service to this church in his "Stewardship" role. She offered a thank you to all committee members for their hard work and wished a Happy 250th Anniversary to our church!

In the absence of a formal Nominating Committee, Moderator Terry Putnam asked for any new names to be added as committee members. Hearing none, committees will remain as is.

Treasurer:

Jim Putnam mentioned the very busy past year he has had as Treasurer and his efforts to operate with utmost transparency. He invited anyone, at any time, to approach him with questions about the church finances or ask to see the financial reports. He also offered his own thank you to Virgil Paggen for his past Stewardship work and how Virgil made it a smooth transition for the Finance Committee to take over the Stewardship record keeping.

Review of 2023 and Proposed 2024 Budgets:

Jim Putnam represented the Finance Committee for this discussion. Jim reviewed the first section of the Budget showing Revenues for actual 2022 figures, proposed 2023 figures, actual 2023 figures, and proposed 2024 figures. Our total budgeted revenue for 2024 is expected to be \$122,524. The remainder of the budget showed actual expenses for 2023 and proposed expenses for 2024. Each section was called to the room's attention, with most being level-funded. Jim explained that the proposed 2024 budget

showed proposed expenses for 2024 at \$150,108 with that leaving a deficit in our budget of \$27,584. As happened in 2023, Finance Committee is hoping for a much smaller deficit than this when the final 2024 figures are in.

Moderator Terry Putnam asked for a motion to accept the 2024 Budget, which was moved, seconded, and with no further discussion except a thank you to Jim, was voted upon and passed unanimously, no opposed.

New Business:

Rev. Paul Nesbit announced that on Sunday, April 14, 2024, we will have a celebration here of the 200th Anniversary of our church building, and the 250th Anniversary of the founding of Southwick Congregational Church. We are planning a luncheon prepared and served by our friends from First Congregational Church of Westfield. Plans need to be made for this event; probably a small fee will be charged for the luncheon. Conference representatives will be in attendance for this celebration. Please reach out to Rev. Paul if you are willing to help plan this.

Moderator Terry Putnam called for a motion to close the 251st Annual Meeting of the Southwick Congregational Church at 12:50 p.m. which was moved, seconded, and passed unanimously. All in attendance stood and sang "Blest Be the Tie That Binds."
