Both of these committees currently are vacant and we need volunteers. Also remember we can always use people on the other Committees such as Long Range Planning, Budget etc. Please let the Office know if you are willing to help.

Just a quick update on some of the projects that are going on: The new camera system has been installed and is working well. We still have some learning to do but it is giving us much better coverage. The pool deck will be replaced in early May. The pool will be drained, cleaned, inspected and any repairs done at the same time. Watch the Topics for the dates it will be out of service. We will also be replacing the carpet and blinds in the Clubhouse this summer.

Because of the rain this spring we have seen quite a few problems with weeds. Please take care of your property.

HOA BOARD OF DIRECTORS & HOMEOWNER'S MEETING MINUTES
Thursday, April 18, 2024

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 am by President Mark Rolfes. Board Members present: Mark Rolfes, Brian Martig, Jack Vishner, George Hyslop, Sue Johnson, Karen Halasz, Don Berghauser and Bob Robinson. There was a moment of silence for those Residents that passed away this past month: Carol Kneisley. The minutes from the March 21, 2024 meeting were approved.

President Mark Rolfes noted that Jill McRae's secretary position needs to be filled. Lois reported that plans for the patio sale were coming along well. Pool deck repair will take place in early May and the pool will be drained and cleaned at this time. Soliciting is not allowed in Pueblo Estates, except for political matters. The sheriff's office will support this rule. Now that people are leaving for the summer, neighbors should keep an eye on nearby houses. The sheriff's sale of 270 Palma is off because the bill was paid to keep the house. This continues to be a complicated issue for the HOA. The new camera has been installed at the pool and is working. Volunteers are needed for several committees.

Budget: The Financial Reports and Budget Summary were made available to the Residents at the meeting. Jack reported our 12-month income was \$446,000, including \$40,000 of non-cash income. Income includes \$9,800 for transfer fees and \$2,900 from the Variety Show. Expenses include \$138,700 for payroll. Utility costs through March for this fiscal year are \$48,800 against \$41,300 budgeted for the entire year. Professional fees, Insurance, and Taxes total \$55,800. For the past 12 months, financials show a net profit of \$28,200, however, without non-cash income, there would be a loss of (\$11,900). Investments include \$69,600 in Money Market funds and \$500,000 in insured CDs.

Delinquencies include 22 property owners owing funds to the HOA. Eighteen of these owe 1 or 2 months. The bank foreclosure has sold and the HOA has received \$500. The HOA foreclosure resulted in a payment of \$52,000, but additional payment is still owed the HOA.

Director's Reports: Sue reported that the kitchen continues to be busy. She requests that users clean up the kitchen and that food left in the refrigerator is labeled. Communications are going fine, as are social events. Sue would like to encourage turn-out for social events.

Brian reported that the new RV storage area lights are working. The RV area gate is getting worn out and will need replacement before too long. To contact Brian, it's best to leave a message on his phone. Folks need to check with Brian for rules on vehicle storage. More pool chairs have been repaired, but more work remains.

George reported on Architecture. People should leave him a phone message to get in contact. The number of applications is down. The javalina house on Rama problem has been taken care of.

Don reported that he is seeing plenty of weeds coming up this time of year. Street light repair is on-going.

Karen reported that weeds are taking off in the common areas and require attention. Work on La Canoa should be done by Pima County. A low tree at La Canoa and Cedro needs to be trimmed. Several large, used Christmas inflatables have been donated to Pueblo Estates.

Resident Comments: Gordon Pierce apologized for his accusations directed at the Beaumont's regarding the election.

Robb Urbanski made a comment about the pink house. He believes it could not be an approved color. Bobbie Vishner commented on the pool chair project.

Adjourned at 10:20 am.
