Bambi exhibits fear inside her kennel with people she doesn't know, like many dogs at the shelter. She retreats to the back of the kennel making herself small. No lunging, growling or aggressive behavior has been notated beyond her arrival at the shelter on August 14th when she had porcupine quills embedded in her face.

Once trust is earned, she comes up to the kennel door, whining with excitement to see you with tail wagging. She leashes easily and returns to the kennel easily also. Outside she walks gently without pulling on the leash, and checks in periodically with her handler. She is wary, but sniffs people with initial curiosity and reserved energy. She shows a healthy curiosity in other dogs in the yard.

With people she trusts, she seeks attention, enjoys pets, allows brushing, takes treats and loves to play ball. Bambi is a sweet dog, that will continue to thrive with gentle humans showing her that she can keep trusting us and no harm will be done to her.

Hello,

I was wanting to share interactions I've had with Bambi (Animal ID #46124 at SCRAPS Shelter).

The first time I interacted with Bambi, she was very fearful of me, but trusted Stephanie to reassure her and lead the initial introduction. I went very slow with her: giving treats, and asking permission before attempting to touch. She did allow me to pet her on the neck and back, but I did not push more than that to start out.

With interactions that followed, I could tell Bambi was starting to recognize me and trust me more. Instead of acting scared and/or barking, she would sniff my hand couple times, accept a treat or two, and continue with what she was doing before I entered the room.
